

FMCSA Requirements:

Driver's will utilize the FMCSA portal to register for the Clearinghouse. The Clearinghouse is a federal program responsible for collecting driver safety records. Driver's will receive a letter by mail with instructions on how to activate the portal.

Below are a few steps for first time users:

Step One: Click "Register" at the top.


The FMCSA Drug & Alcohol Clearinghouse is using Login.gov to allow you to sign in to your account safely and securely.

Are you FMCSA or State Driver Licensing Agency personnel?
FMCSA enforcement and SDLA staff do not need to create a login.gov account to access the Clearinghouse. This includes staff from Departments of Motor Vehicles.
