Haslett Schools Welcomes New K-12 Teachers

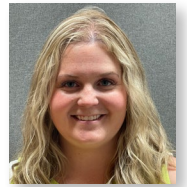

Continuing our **A+** Tradition

Haslett Public Schools has a long tradition of academic excellence and providing educational opportunities which enable students of all aspirations and abilities to grow and learn. Our ultimate goal for the upcoming school year is to ensure all students are successful. This would not be possible without the support of our staff, parents, and the community of Haslett Public Schools. Thank you for partnering with us as we begin another new school year.

This summer, our Administrative team worked together to develop our district goals for the 2023-24 school year. The Administrative Goals are divided into five (5) core areas: Student Instruction, Technology, Fiscal Responsibility, Community, and School Safety. Goals are presented to the Haslett Board of Education in August and implemented and evaluated throughout the school year. These goals will be available to the public after they have been presented to the Haslett Board of Education.

We encourage you to follow our progress throughout the 2023-24 school year by way of various communications sent out from our buildings, departments, staff, and my office. Information can also be obtained by visiting the district website and subscribing to the Haslett A+ app. Keeping you informed is a top priority for Haslett Public Schools. As we look to begin the new school year, here are some of the goals we will be implementing:

Safety and Security

The safety and security of our students and staff continue to be a top priority for Haslett Public Schools. A few of the additional measures put in place over the summer months include:

- Hiring of a full-time School Resource Officer
- Installing protective window film on all school entrances and high visibility areas
- Installing strobe alarm lock-down warning system at all school buildings
- Upgrading locks on all classroom doors, which will remain locked at all times
- Adding additional cameras throughout the district to cover any identified areas of interest.

Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI)

The district began its efforts to implement the newly adopted (June 2022) DEI plan during the 2022-23 school year. Stephanie Livingston, District DEI Coordinator and Haslett High School Intervention Specialist, has been leading the implementation efforts for our district. Individual building team leaders, district staff, and the district-wide DEI committees have also been involved in the implementation process.

During the 2023-24 school year, we will continue to work with these groups to meet the goals set forth in the previous year. The efforts we will be focusing on this year include:

- Establishing a process for responding to incidents of bias
- Hiring and retention of staff
- Family and community engagement

These goals represent only a portion of the work to be completed during this school year. Additional information regarding our DEI plan can be found on the [District's DEI website](#). Other updates on our progress will be presented at Board of Education Meetings and in my weekly publications.

Curriculum Improvements

Into-Reading, a new K-5 reading curriculum, was purchased and implemented during the 2021-22 school year. Reveal Math, a new K-12 math curriculum, was partially implemented during the 2022-23 school year, with full implementation expected this year. Both of these programs are aligned with Michigan's Academic Standards and have significantly increased academic rigor. We will continue our efforts to implement both of these curriculums during the 2023-24 school year and provide professional development and collaboration time for teachers. We have already begun to see the benefits for students in mastery of content and improved student achievement.

We are excited to welcome back staff and students to the new school year. Thank you for your continued support of Haslett Public Schools. Feel free to contact my office if you have any questions or concerns.

Haslett Public Schools Welcomes School Resource Officer

Haslett High School is pleased to announce the hiring of Officer Kolby Casaday as our new full-time School Resource Officer. Officer Casaday, a 2012 alumni of Haslett High School, has been working in our school buildings since the beginning of the 2022-23 school year as a part-time officer. This new position is a result of a long-standing partnership with Meridian Township Police and a grant from the State of Michigan.

Officer Casaday will be dedicating 100% of his time to our district, serving all instructional buildings. The role of the School Resource Officer is to foster positive relationships with students and faculty, provide opportunities for collaboration with administration and mental health staff, and proactively address school safety issues. For students, the School Resource Officer will work in unison with school staff to promote the positive development of youth, prevent school-based incidents, and work with school officials to promote a peaceful school environment.

Officer Casaday will also assist in responding to school emergencies, deal with trespassers, and serve our school community by providing training to students, parents/guardians, and staff, along with answering student questions.

The safety of our staff, students, and the community continues to be a top priority for Haslett Public Schools. We believe our new full-time School Resource Officer will help achieve our goal of increased safety. The district extends a special thank you to the Meridian Township Board and the Meridian Township Police Department for their continued support of our district.



Student Records Kept Confidential

Student information is confidential and may be released ONLY with prior approval from a parent or guardian, according to established Board of Education policy.

On request, we will release a student's name, class/grade, extracurricular activities, achievements, awards or honors, height or weight (if member of an athletic team), photograph, previous school(s) attended, and health records, unless a parent or guardian specifies otherwise.

At the beginning of each school year, we ask parents to select an option for the release of their child's information. There are three options: total access, limited access, and total denial.

Total Access: Information is provided to whomever asks.

Limited Access: Information is provided for educational purposes.

Total Denial: Information is NOT provided to anyone.

Parents or eligible students who believe information on record is inaccurate may request the information be corrected or deleted. This request should be made in writing to the building principal.

Asbestos Reminder

Each year, the Haslett School District is obligated to remind the community that some asbestos materials exist in parts of our original school buildings. Federal guidelines state that if the asbestos building materials are in good condition and do not pose a health threat, it is best to leave the materials intact. Bus Schedules Elementary

For Murphy and Ralya students who live within the walking area boundaries: All children in grades 2-5 will walk to their school. In the morning, there is a shuttle bus available for students to transfer from one elementary school to another. Students should be at their bus stop five minutes early.

- Bus routes/stops will be adjusted once school begins.
- Wilkshire students may be transferred to different buses after arriving at Ralya/Murphy.
- Bus times are approximate and may be delayed during the first week of school.
- The “ / ” symbol denotes stops made at intersections.
- “After school” routines may vary slightly.

Haslett Public Schools Transportation Discipline Policy

We believe all students can behave appropriately and safely while riding the school bus. We will not tolerate any students stopping a driver from doing their job, or preventing other students from having safe transportation.

The **first time** a student chooses to break a rule, the following consequences are applied:

- Verbal warning
- Student conference with driver
- Assigned seat and/or call to the parent forewarning the parent that their child could be suspended from bus transportation if misbehavior continues

If a student does not respond to the above consequences, the following procedures will be followed:

- 1st Incident:** Student receives a bus discipline report prepared by the bus driver, and bus driver calls the parent.
- 2nd Incident:** Student receives a bus discipline report prepared by the bus driver, and the transportation supervisor calls the parent.
- 3rd Incident:** Student is **suspended** from bus transportation for three school days, with an optional conference with principal/parent/bus driver/student.
- 4th Incident:** Student is **suspended** from bus transportation for ten school days, with an optional conference with principal/parent/bus driver/student.
- 5th Incident:** Student is **suspended** from bus transportation for the remainder of the school year.

Standard Crossing Procedure

Aides are available on Haslett School District Kindergarten bus runs for the first two weeks of school. If your child needs to cross the street at the bus stop, our aides will teach the preferred procedure as outlined below:

- Always cross in front of the bus.
- Take eight giant steps at the curb next to the bus so the driver can see your feet.
- Look up - school bus drivers will touch their hand to their forehead as a signal that it is safe to cross.
- Stop at the traffic side of the bus, look both ways before continuing across, and cross only if no cars are approaching.
- Do not stop or go back if you drop something.
- Stop at once if the horn blows.

Cameras on Board Buses

Currently, all of our school buses have cameras on board, as well as on the outside of school buses, providing our bus drivers with the ability to observe motorists. **The pictures of vehicles in violation of bus safety rules will be submitted to the local police.**

The camera system provides better safety and security for all of our students who use district transportation.

Follow the Rules for Bus Safety

To help ensure safe transportation for all our children, please review these rules carefully:

1. Students must be at their pick-up location **five minutes before** scheduled pick-up time. Bus drivers will not wait for tardy students.
2. Students must form a line and wait until the bus has come to a complete stop and the door is opened before boarding. Students must remain seated until the bus has come to a complete stop and the door is opened before getting off the bus.
3. During the bus ride, students are expected to remain in their seat keeping their feet out of the aisles, off the seats, and off the backs of the seats in front of them.
4. No talking or noise is allowed when the bus is approaching or crossing railroad tracks.
5. Side windows may be lowered only half way.
6. No loud talking, shouting, whistling, or profanity is allowed on the bus at any time.
7. No fighting, wrestling, or horseplay will be tolerated.
8. Animals (including reptiles, amphibians, and birds), skateboards, weapons, knives, fireworks, and dangerous objects are prohibited. Aisles must be kept clear at all times. Items not able to fit under the student's seat are prohibited. Eating, smoking, chewing tobacco, or possession of intoxicants or illegal substances is prohibited.
9. Anyone apprehended for deliberately damaging a bus (tearing seats, breaking windows, etc.) will be suspended from riding the bus and held financially responsible for repair or replacement.
10. No glass containers are allowed on the bus.
11. A written request from the parent, approved by the principal, will be necessary before a student may be admitted or discharged at a stop other than his/her regular stop, or be allowed to ride a bus other than his/her assigned route.
12. Transportation will be denied to any unauthorized persons.
13. Cell phones are prohibited from use on the bus. MP3 players, iPods, and radios with headphones are permitted.
14. Students will be suspended from riding a school bus for failure to obey the rules or when their actions in any way are considered detrimental to the rights, safety, and property of others or to the control of the bus.

Integrated Pest Management (*Advisory to Parents/Guardians*)

Dear Parent or Guardian:

State of Michigan law requires that schools and day care centers that may apply pesticides on school or day care property must provide an annual advisory to parents or guardians of students attending the facility.

Please be advised that Haslett Public Schools utilizes an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) approach to control pests. IPM is a pest management system that utilizes all suitable techniques in a total pest management system with the intent of preventing pests from reaching unacceptable levels or to reduce an existing population to an acceptable level. Pest management techniques emphasize sanitation, pest exclusion, and biological controls. One of the objectives of using an IPM approach is to reduce or eliminate the need for chemical applications of pesticides. However, certain situations may require the need for pesticides to be utilized.

As required by State of Michigan law, you will receive advance notice regarding the non-emergency application of a pesticide such as an insecticide, fungicide or herbicide, other than a bait or gel formulation, that is made to our buildings or grounds during this school year. Notification is not given for the use of sanitizers, germicides, disinfectants or anti-microbial cleaners. In certain emergencies, such as an infestation of stinging insects, pesticides may be applied without prior notice to prevent injury to students, but you will be notified following any such application.

Advance notification of pesticide applications, other than a bait or gel formulation, will be given by at least two (2) methods. The first method will be by posting at the main entrance of the building. The second method will be by posting information on our website.

Please be advised that parents or guardians are entitled to receive the advance notice of a pesticide application, other than a bait or gel formulation, by first class United States mail postmarked at least 3 days before the pesticide application, if they so request. If you prefer to receive the notification by first class mail, please contact the District Operations office at (517) 540-8010 to be added to the list.

Parents or guardians of children attending Haslett Public Schools may review the district's Integrated Pest Management program and records of any pesticide application upon request.
