Haslett Schools of Choice Applications Available (May 1 - May 30, 2024)

Application Information

Haslett Public Schools participates in the State of Michigan Schools of Choice (SOC) program as outlined in Section 105 and 105c of the State School Aid Act. This means that non-resident students can be enrolled without having to obtain approval from the district of residence. Families who have moved out of the district, or who plan to move out of the district prior to the beginning of the 2024-25 school year, will need to complete a SOC application. Applications will be available May 1 - May 30, 2024.

Parents/guardians interested in applying to Haslett Public Schools for SOC may visit the district website at www.haslett.k12.mi.us to complete the application. If you need assistance in completing the online application, please contact the Superintendent's Office at (517) 339-8242.

Eligibility

The State of Michigan SOC program allows enrollment of students residing in school districts located in contiguous intermediate school districts. The district is accepting two (2) students per grade in grades 1-8, five (5) students in grades 9-12, and twenty-five (25) students in Kindergarten.

If eligible applications do not exceed the designated number, all eligible applications must be accepted. Other students must be selected according to a random draw system and serve as a waiting list. If your child has been suspended within the preceding two years or has ever been expelled, the district may refuse to accept your SOC application.

Notification

Parents will be notified by letter no later than June 30, 2024, if their child has been accepted to attend Haslett Public Schools for the 2024-25 school year. If you choose to accept, you should enroll your child upon acceptance, and you will be expected to provide your own transportation.

A parent does not need to complete a SOC application each year if the student remains enrolled. If, however, a parent decided to withdraw a SOC student to homeschool or attend another school district during the previous school year, they must reapply to be accepted for the upcoming school year.
