State of Michigan Assessments Begin After Spring Break

The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) and the Office of Educational Assessment and Accountability (OEAA) are preparing for the 2023-24 administration of the Michigan Student Test of Educational Process (M-STEP), along with the Michigan Merit Exam (MME), PSAT assessments, and the MI-Access alternate assessments. Spring of 2024 will be the third administration of the new M-STEP Science assessments, as well as the initial year for the realigned MI-Access Science assessment. These new science assessments are fully aligned to Michigan's current science content standards, including the alternate content expectations. This year also brings modified M-STEP and MME testing windows, as well as another year of benchmark assessment administration and data reporting.

More detailed information about M-STEP, SAT, ACT WorkKeys, PSAT 8, PSAT 9, and PSAT 10 will be sent out by individual school buildings.

Return to Learn Law

In August 2020, the Return to Learn (RTL) legislation was passed into law. This law required districts to create an Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan that provided the educational goals the district expected to achieve during the year. The plan included an assurance that the district would administer benchmark assessments to determine whether ALL students in grades K-8 were making meaningful progress towards mastering the state academic standards in reading and math.

These NWEA benchmark assessments are administered three times a year. The law encouraged school districts to administer the same benchmark assessment or assessments that it administered in previous years. Haslett Public Schools chose to administer NWEA to students in grades K-10, one of four approved assessment providers by the State of Michigan.
