\$9,500 in Scholarships

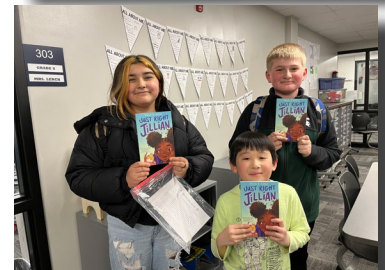
We distributed scholarships to graduating Haslett seniors:

- 100 Women for Haslett (1 recipient)
- Hagenbuch Memorial Scholarships (6 recipients)



\$18,510 in Teacher/Program Grants

Our grants supported purchases of graphing calculators, BeeBots, morning bin supplies, play center materials, diversity and emotional learning resources, ukuleles, band equipment, and books for the One Book One School program.
