October is College and Career Awareness Month for the state of Michigan. As a proud partner with the Michigan College Access Network (MCAN), Haslett students have the opportunity to participate in a variety of college and career awareness activities this month.

District-wide College and Career Awareness Day (Tuesday, October 24) All HPS staff and students are invited to wear a college/career/military branch shirt to school and to have intentional conversations with one another about these topics. The conversations will be developmentally appropriate for each grade level.
