1. Suggested motion - “That the Pitman Board of Education accepts the submission of the American Rescue Plan Act Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ARP ESSER) Homeless Children and Youth (ARP-HCY) Funding in the amount of \$8,060.00.”
2. Suggested motion - “That the Pitman Board of Education approves the renewal of NutriServe as the Food Service Management Service for the 2022/2023 school year in the amount of \$27,125.00 an increase from 2021/2022 of \$1,875.00 (guaranteed profit of \$5,000.00)” (approved on April 20, 2022)

Salary in accord with the negotiated agreement with the Pitman Administrators’ Association.”
