As part of its mission, Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity has undertaken programs aimed at enriching and improving life for African-American youth nationwide. One of our key programs is identifying and supporting African-American male students who plan to enter college. As part of this effort, the local chapter of the fraternity, Gamma Gamma Boulé, awards a minimum of one scholarship annually for four years in the minimum amount of \$1,500.

We make every effort to maintain contact with the recipients of our scholarship after they have enrolled in college, and if they are making satisfactory progress towards obtaining their degree, they are considered for continued support each year that they are full-time students up to a maximum of four (4) total years.

We are asking metropolitan Austin, Texas area high school principals, guidance counselors, and advisors to identify those African-American-male senior students in your schools who might qualify for our scholarship, and forward the application materials to their attention. With your assistance, we believe we will be able to continue to support our local students.

Criteria for Gamma Gamma Boulé Scholarship - 2023

Gamma Gamma Boule's Social Action Committee (Scholarship Sub-Committee) will select the recipient(s) for the Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity, Gamma Gamma Boulé Scholarship. The scholarship award is in the minimum amount of one thousand five-hundred dollars (\$1500.00) for four years. The scholarship will be paid directly to the student upon verification by his accredited college/university that he is enrolled as a full-time student, carrying a minimum of 12 semester hours.

To qualify for the scholarship, the student must:

- Be an African-American male high school graduating senior enrolled in an Austin-area high school on a full-time basis
- Have attained a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale/4.0 on 5.0 scale
- Intend to attend a four-year college or university upon graduation
- Demonstrate leadership potential and good-citizenship along with community involvement and/or service.
- > Provide a one-page biographical sketch explaining why he wants to attend college
- Provide a letter of recommendation from one of the following: his teacher, his counselor, or one of his school administrators.
- Provide a copy of his transcript.
- > Properly complete the application form provided.
- **If candidate is chosen to receive a scholarship, he will be expected to participate in at least one Gamma Gamma Social Action/Community event each year either virtually or in person where the scholar's schedule permits.

Submit the completed application, with narrative, letter, and transcript to the address or email below in time to be received not later than **Friday, May 5, 2023**
