



Music has a direct relationship to our children's entire educational program:

Science

Music is a specialized science which deals with the qualities of sound, acoustics and timbre.

Mathematics

Counting in groups of two, three, four and higher is used consistently in all music repertoire. When teaching rhythmic values, we reinforce the concepts of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Geography

Music is inclusive of, yet unique to every culture on earth. Through music we raise awareness of the world around us.

History

Music acts as a blueprint, testimonial and archive to people and events of the past. As musicians, we are able to experience a piece of history through performance.

Language

Most of the music we perform is derived from western European civilization. Through the text and terminology used, students gain significant knowledge of Italian and Latin, and, to a lesser degree, German, French, Hebrew, Spanish and other languages. Many root words, prefixes and suffixes of these languages found their way into the English language.

Physical Education

When starting and developing the instrumental and vocal musician, a significant amount of time is spent on developing proper breathing technique. Rehearsals, if properly orchestrated, can be as intensive and exhaustive as jogging or swimming laps. Motor skills are advanced substantially. As with all sports organizations, the concepts of teamwork and cooperation are exploited in the ensemble setting.
