

USE OF PREPAID  
MEAL CARD OR AC-  
COUNT TO PUR-  
CHASE MEALS  
SERVED AT SCHOOL

Any student who has money in his/her account, but incurs a negative balance based on that day's food purchase may charge his/her meal for that day with no replacement of items.

Once a student passes his/her charging limit with a negative balance, he/she is offered an alternative lunch with all side options (fruit, dessert, milk, and vegetable of his/her choice from that days offering) and an entrée meal of a cheese sandwich instead of that day's entrée. Breakfast includes two slices of toast and that day's side offerings (milk, fruit).
