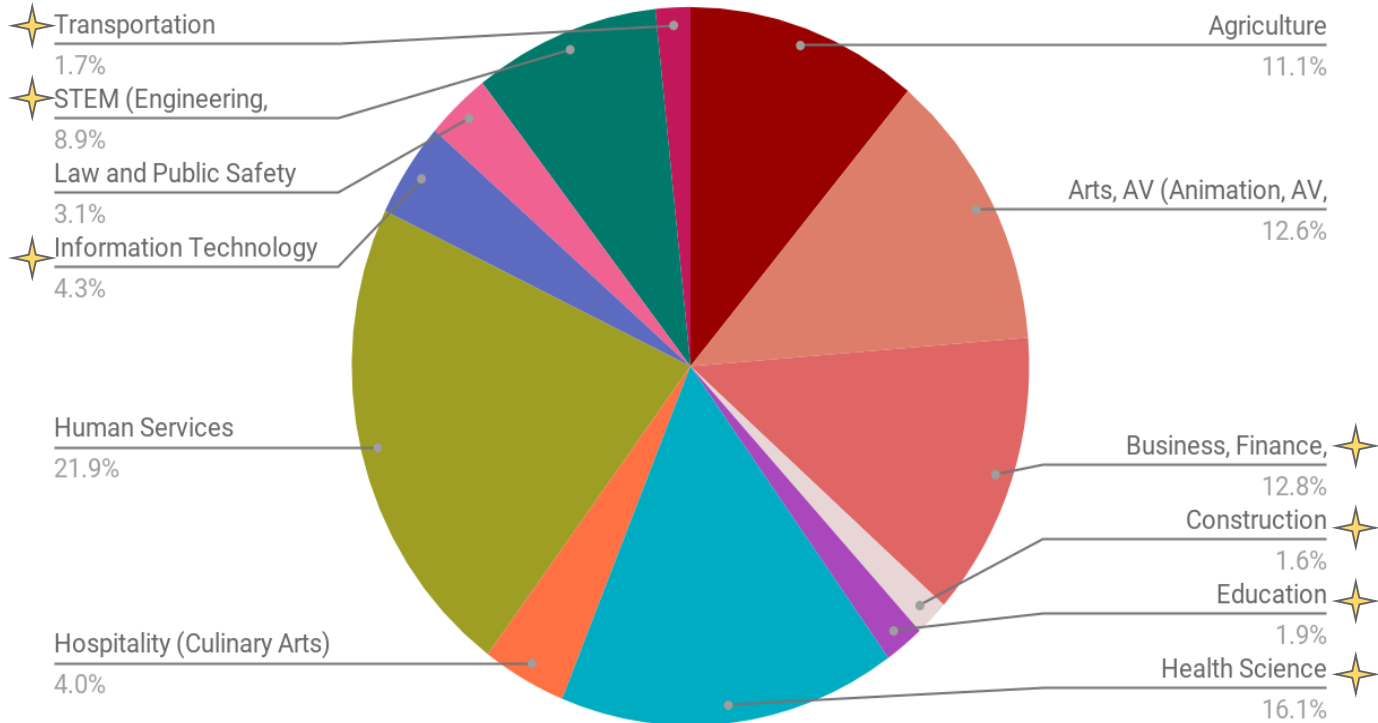

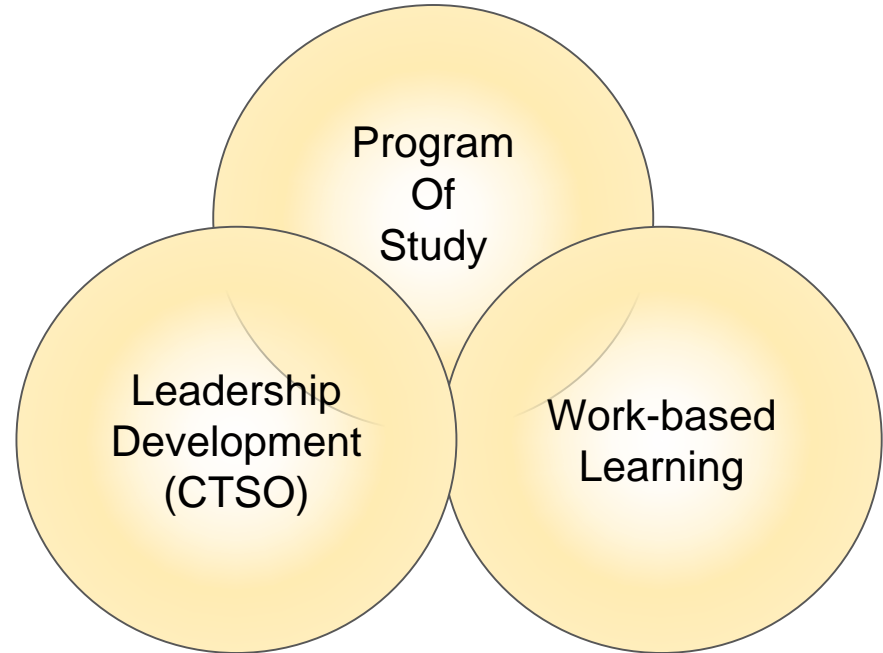

CTE Updates: Federal, State, Local

Federal legislation was updated: [Perkins V](#)

- Emphasis on special populations
- Focus on programs of study
- Requires a local comprehensive needs assessment
- Career exploration in “middle grades” (5-8)
- Includes a “program quality” measure each state will report (WBL, college credit, or IBC)
 - Texas chose industry based certifications (IBC)



State updates: HB 3

- Teacher salary increases \$
- Full-day Pre- K and early literacy
- CCMR Outcomes Bonuses and additional CTE supports \$
- Property tax reform and recapture reduction \$
