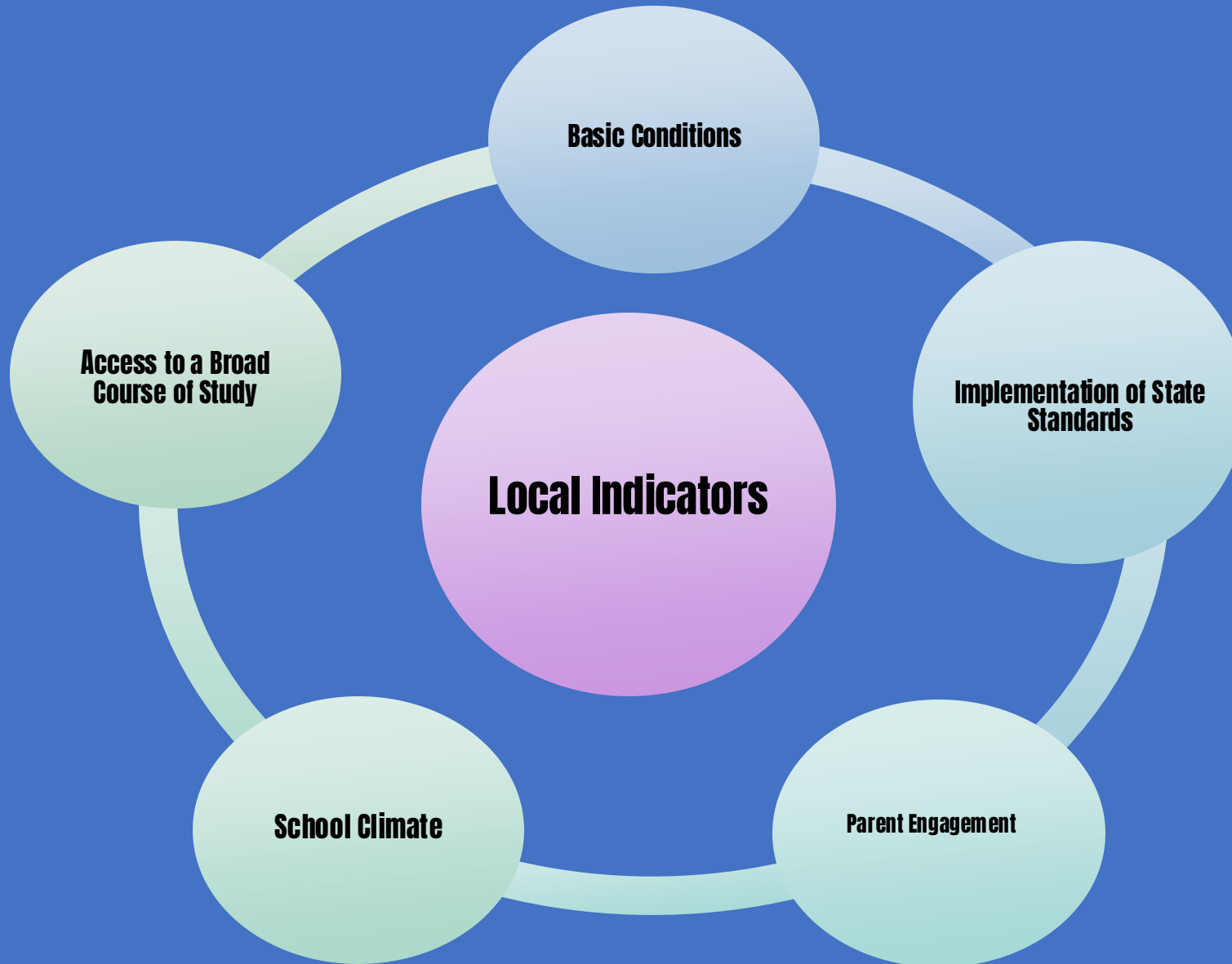

What are Local Indicators?

California's accountability system is based on a *multiple measures system* that assesses how our district and schools are meeting the needs of our students.

Priority Area	State Indicator	Local Indicator

What are Local Indicators?



- Measured through *reflection tools* that are provided by the California Department of Education.
- Measured annually and *shared with the Board*
- Uploaded to the *California Dashboard* in the Fall
- Reported as:
 - *Standard Met*
 - *Not Met*
 - *Not Met for 2 or more years.*

Basic Services and Conditions (Priority 1)

What is included in the *self reflection tool*?

- Percentage of appropriately assigned teachers
- Percentage of student without access to aligned instructional materials
- Number of identified instances when facilities do not meet the “good repair” standard

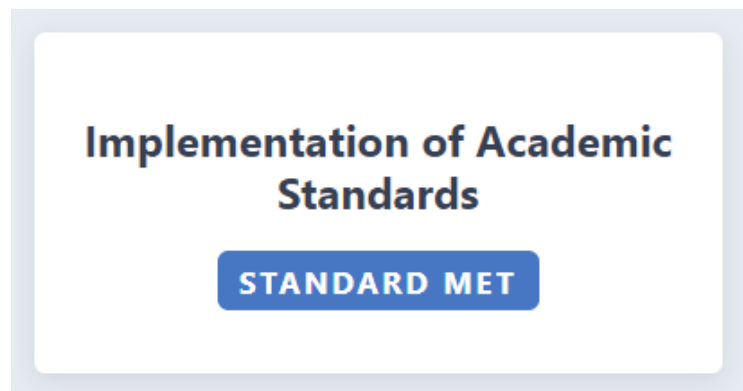

Implementation of State Academic Standard (Priority 2)

What is included in the *self reflection tool*?

- Rating scales for progress in *providing professional learning for teaching* to the recently adopted academic standards and/or curriculum frameworks
- Rating scales for progress in *making instructional materials* that are aligned to the recently adopted academic standards and/or curriculum frameworks
- Rating scales for progress in *implementing policies or programs* to support staff in identifying areas where they can improve in delivering instruction aligned to the recently adopted academic standards and/or curriculum frameworks
- Rating scales for progress in *implementing each of the following academic standards* adopted by the state board for all students
- Rating scales for *professional development reflection*

What is included in the self reflection tool?

- Rating scales for progress in *Building Relationship Between School Staff and Families*
- Rating scales for progress in *Building Partnerships for Student Outcomes*
- Rating scales for progress in *Seeking Input for Decision Making*
