Lawn Games Study Guide

Bocce

Object of the game:

To score the most points by ending each round with your color bocce balls closest to the pallino (point ball). Each player rolls 4 bocce balls.

Scoring:

- 1. The game is played to 12 points.
- 2. At the end of each frame, the team closest to the pallino will get 1 point for each bocce ball that is closer than the closest bocce ball of their opponents.

Playing the game:

- 1. One player rolls the pallino at least halfway down the designated playing area.
- 2. The same player who threw the pallino then rolls one of his/her bocce balls trying to get as close to the pallino as possible.
- 3. Team 2 then rolls, trying to get their ball closer to the pallino then team 1.
- 4. If team 2 gets closer it becomes team 1's turn again.
- 5. If team 2 does not get closer, team 2 continues to roll until they get one of their bocce balls closer.
- 6. Each team can knock the other team's ball away from the pallino by rolling and hitting the opposing team's ball.
- 7. After both teams roll all 4 of their bocce balls, the team with the closest bocce ball to the pallino is the only team that can score points for that frame.
- 8. The game may be played by 2 people (singles) or by 4 people (doubles).

Washers

How to play:

- 1. Washers may be played with either two or four players.
- 2. Each player has four washers.
- 3. Players take turns throwing washers at the opposite box and can.
- 4. The game is played to 21.

Scoring:

- 1. Bulls Eye a washer that lands in and stays in the cup is worth 3 points.
- 2. Box a washer that lands in and stays in the box is worth 1 point.
- 3. Scratch washers that are neither in the can or in the box are worth 0 points.
- 4. Only one team can score per round.

Scoring Example:

- 1. Team 1 has 2 washers in the box = 2 points and 1 washer in the can = 3 points. Team 1 has a total of 5 points.
- 2. Team 2 has 3 washers in the box = 3 points and 0 washers in the can = 0 points. Team 2 has a total of 3 points.
 - Since only one team can score in washers, Team 1 had 5 points and Team 2 had 3 points. 5-3 leaves Team 1 with 2 points for the 1st round.
