



SENIOR SCHOOL UNIFORM LIST

Our students wear their School uniform with great pride and our items serve a practical purpose, as well as enabling our students to identify with their school community. Items described as *RGS items* are unique to the school and must be obtained from our suppliers **Schoolblazer**.



SIZING

Schoolblazer have a very helpful *intelligent sizing* system on their website; simply input your child's measurements and they will recommend the best products.

NAMING

Like sports kit we advise that all uniform is clearly named. Schoolblazer offer a service which means your items can arrive pre-labelled.

HAIR

Hair should be clean and tidy at all times. If shaved, a grade two is the shortest it may be. Teachers may require students to tie back their hair for health and safety reasons. Hair slides must be plain, dark brown, black, navy or maroon only; ribbons or scrunchies – dark brown, black, navy or maroon. If a student wears a headscarf, then it should be of a plain, subdued colour in keeping with the school uniform, and allow the student's full face to be seen.

IEWELLERY

With the exception of watches, jewellery should not be worn, unless of a religious nature or for medical reasons.

Students with pierced ears are allowed to wear one pair of plain gold or silver coloured studs (one in each ear). For sport, earrings must be removed at home on days when they have sport.

GENDER

There are lots of different RGS sports items available on the **Kitlocker** website, which we know can feel overwhelming! There are also some non-branded items that you might want to buy elsewhere.





NAMING


