Initiative 1

Continue to provide A+ College Ready Curriculum and Advanced Placement Courses for grades 9-12.

Activities:

- 1) *Employ Attendance Officer and 1.55 Teachers – Title 1 \$127,899.00*
- 2) *Attend Professional Development – Title 1 \$6,822.04*

Intended Outcomes:

Initiative 2

Partner with Beville State Community College to provide opportunities for academic dual enrollment and to obtain career technical certification.
