- NCAA Division I requirements:
 - 10 out of the 16 required cores have to be completed by the end of your junior year
 - Must have a core 2.3 GPA
 - They will allow a minimum of 2.0 GPA, but you will not be allowed to play your freshman year of college
- *If you are a current junior or sophomore considering playing sports after high school and are NOT on advanced or honors diploma you will need to meet with your counselor.

Advanced Placement

- ◆ Courses currently offered at FCHS:
Biology, English Language, English Literature, US History, US Government, PreCalculus
- ◆ AP courses help students acquire the skills and habits demanded for success in college.
- ◆ Students establish rigorous study habits, improve writing skills, sharpen problem-solving abilities, develop time management skills, and strengthen self-discipline.
- ◆ Students may earn college credit while enrolled in high school courses (see college websites for specific credits)

AP & the Cost of College

- The average cost of a 4 year public institution is \$18,000 for every year, in state.
- If a student earns a qualifying score in an AP course and receives college credit, the family saves \$1,800 which is the average cost of a 3 hour course at Alabama & Auburn
- AP helps students qualify for college scholarship dollars. 31% of colleges use AP as a criterion when determining scholarship recipients.
- Colleges use AP to place students in appropriate level courses.

College Tuition Costs

What does college cost?



Auburn University

- Tuition & Fees=\$6,268
- Books-\$800
- Room & Board-\$7,698
- Total=\$14,766/semester (\$118,128 four year total)

University of Alabama

- Tuition & Fees=\$5,550
- Books-\$800
- Room & Board-\$6,967
- Total=\$13,317/semester (\$106,536 four year total)

- Note: Out of state tuition is usually 2-3 times that of an in-state student regardless of college.

FCHS Career Tech Programs

- ◆ Health Science
 - ◆ Architecture & Construction
 - ◆ Business Management
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- If you complete a sequence of 3 courses in one of these areas, a CT endorsement is added to your diploma.
 - Fine Arts count towards your career tech electives

Career Technical Dual Enrollment

- Earning a high school credit and a college credit at the same time.
- Students in grades 10 - 12 are eligible.
- Required GPA of 2.0 except for Career Pathways which requires a 3.0.
- No cost to courses for with dual enrollment scholarship.
- Most of the courses are taught at BSCC.
- Transportation is provided to BSCC.
- All BSCC paperwork must be completed by certain timelines.

BSCC Career Technical Programs

- MSSC
- Career Pathways
- Electrical Systems
- Welding
- Office Management
- Child Development
- Computer Science

Academic Dual Enrollment

- Earning a high school credit and a college credit at the same time.
- Juniors and Seniors are eligible to take academic DE.
- For math (22) and English (18) students must have the minimum ACT score required or a required ACCUPLACER (Math 20, English 18) score to be eligible to take these courses.
- Academic DE is weighted with a +10.
- Academic DE costs approximately \$500 per class.
- All courses are taught at BSCC.
- No transportation provided
- All BSCC paperwork must be completed by certain timelines.

Academic DE Course Offerings

- English Composition 101 and 102 (11 & 12)
- Biology with Lab 103 (12)
- Math 112 and 113 or 115 and 125 (12)
- U.S. History 201 and 202 (11 & 12)
