

Option #1 One Pager

Write a letter to the author of the novel. Be sure to include your opinions on the novel- positive and negative. Discuss the protagonist (main character) and what you learned from them.

Option #4 **Quote Me**

Select FIVE quotes from the novel. Choose quotes that reflect your thinking and noticing about the novel. State who said the quote, in what context, and explain in your own words. Discuss why this quote is significant to the novel.

Option #5 **Design a New Cover**

Redesign the cover. Use images and/or words to create the perfect new cover. Explain why you created this cover.

Write a comic strip for one scene in the novel. Be sure to include the protagonist (main character), setting, and a problem.

Create a soundtrack for your summer reading novel. Explain why you picked each of the songs that you did.


