We read the stories of others to "walk in their shoes" and expand our worlds.







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






## Departmental Philosophy in Action: Guiding Tenets for 2023-24

- Refining curriculum, assessment, & progress monitoring systems for teachers ("sane and sustainable")











## 2024-25 Proposed K-6 Elementary ELA & Reading Budget






## 2024-25 Proposed Secondary ELA & Reading Budget




### 2024-25 Proposed Elementary Library Budget


