Please don't be stressed about gathering various school supplies. It is helpful for students to have an organizational system that may include a ringed binder, accordion folder or separate folders for each class. Math classes will frequently use dry erase markers, so be sure to have one at all times.

GENERAL SUPPLIES

- No. 2 Pencils
- Blue or black pens
- Dry erase markers (blue or black)
- Red Pen
- Post-it notes 3" x 3"
- Highlighters (4 different colors)
- Scientific Calculator (example: TI-30X IIS) (Pre-Algebra and Algebra only)
- Standard Calculator (math, except Pre-Algebra and Algebra)
- Colored Pencils (only carry as needed)
- Loose leaf college ruled paper- no need for a whole pack to be carried at all times
- Organizer for loose paper: (examples: Notebook/Accordion Folder/Folders)
*In middle school, it is important that students develop habits that will assist in keeping organized. A three ring binder is one way to help students stay organized. In lieu of the binder, you may choose other methods that work for your student.
- Mead Composition (not spiral) 100 page college ruled notebooks (1 for math, 1 for Language Arts, 1 for Social Studies, 1 for Science.
- Inexpensive, wired earbuds or headphones
- LSSD issued Chromebook
- Laced athletic shoes (closed toed)

Choir

All Choir students will need the following supplies:

- One-inch, 3-ring binder
- Composition notebook
- Pencil
- Highlighters

Band

All Band students will need the following supplies:

- One-inch, 3-ring binder and 20 clear page protectors OR A folder assigned only for band
- Composition book
- Band Book (see below)
- Cleaning Kit for all instruments (except Electric Bass). ALL wind students must have a cleaning swab for their instrument
- Reeds for Clarinet and saxophone players
 - All band students: #2.5, box of 10 to start
 - Preferred brands are Rico or Vandoren
 - Intermediate: students should have a set of 3.0 sized reeds

Supplies can be ordered through Ted Brown along with your instrument rental, or from Kennelly Music, Amazon, etc...

****Families borrowing a school instrument will still need to purchase their own cleaning kit, reeds, and book. Please contact Miss Zickefoose if this creates a financial hardship.**

BOOKS

- Beginning Band = Essential Elements, Book 1
- Be sure to order the book for your student's instrument. The books are:
 - Flute
 - Bb Clarinet
 - Eb Alto Saxophone
 - Bb Tenor Saxophone
 - Bb Trumpet
 - Trombone
 - Baritone/Euphonium B.C. (Bass Clef)
 - Electric Bass
- Intermediate Band = we will begin the year with the same Sound Innovations Book 1 that we used last year. In October we will move on to Essential Elements, Book Two.

BUYER BEWARE - be aware of purchasing an "off-brand" instrument from Amazon.com or Costco. Although they seem affordable they will be cheaply made. Damage may not be fixable or will cost more than you paid for the instrument. Students usually become frustrated with the sound they get out of it and often dislike the feel of the instrument.

Some reputable brands include: Yamaha, Jupiter, Conn, Germeinhardt, Bach, Selmer, Jean-Paul. Ms. Zickefoose will be happy to talk with you regarding the purchase of an instrument.
