

- What utility bills/documents are accepted as proof of residency?
 - Electricity
 - Water
 - Gas
 - Garbage
 - Internet
 - Government Document*
 - Lease Agreement**
 - Mortgage
 - Satellite/Cable
 - * Only <u>ONE</u> government document will be accepted as a proof of residency.
 - ** All lease agreements must be Signed by the Property Owner and Notarized.
- What if I don't have a proof of residency or only have one proof of residency?
 - Students with special circumstances must visit the Superintendent's Office for approval to register.
- Can a grandparent, aunt/uncle, cousin, or sibling register my child?
 - No. Only a custodial parent or legal guardian can register a child.
 - If you have custody papers regarding your child, you must visit the Superintendent's Office with those documents for approval before visiting the school to complete registration.
- Is the online registration process considered complete upon submission?
 - No. Additional steps are necessary. Reach out to your child's school if you are unsure of your next steps.
- What school supplies does my child need?
 - Each school will post a school supply list online and make it available at Wal-Mart in June 2024.
- What if I live with someone else?
 - You must have a current, notarized lease agreement signed by the property owner AND another acceptable proof of residency.
 - You must also have the Township/Range document with the property owner's name and address on the document.
- I am new to the district. What documents do I need to register my child?
 - You will need your child's birth certificate, immunization/shot records, two proofs of residency, township/range document, and a withdrawal form from the previous school.



• Can I enroll multiple children at the same time?

- You must sign in to each student's account in Active Parent to complete his/her registration.
- You must also provide the required documents for each child.

• How do I find out which school district we belong to?

• Your school district is determined by your home address.

• What if my child hasn't been fully immunized?

- Mississippi law requires children to be immunized to attend public school.
- If your child is not fully immunized, contact your healthcare provider or the local health department about obtaining the necessary vaccinations.
- If you have an underlying circumstance or health condition, please reach out to the Superintendent's Office.

• Are there any age requirements for Kindergarten enrollment?

• Yes. Children must be five years old on or before September 1st of the school year in which they plan to enroll in Kindergarten.

• What if my child has special education needs?

- Inform the school during registration so that appropriate school records can be obtained.
- A staff member will guide you through the process of developing an Individual Education Plan (IEP) to ensure your child receives the appropriate support and services.

• Is there a deadline for registration?

• Registration for the 2024-2025 school year is scheduled for <u>May 1-17</u>. This registration will take the place of Summer Registration.

• Who can I contact if I have more questions?

• Contact each school if you have additional registration questions.

- What happens after I submit the registration?
 - The school district will review your documents and either confirm your child's enrollment or request additional documentation.
 - Following the confirmation, information regarding the start date, school supplies, and any orientation sessions will be provided.
- Will a bill with "in care of" work for registration?
 - No.
- What if I do not have internet access or a device to register my child?
 - Contact your child's school to make an appointment for registration.
- Is the technology fee required?
 - Yes.
- Where can I find more information about the 7th Grade TDAP shot?
 - Contact your local healthcare provider or the Mississippi Department of Health Services regarding the TDAP shot.
 - The TDAP shot is required for all 7th grade students.
