Welcome to OLOM Instrumental Music! The following is a description of the program in terms of classroom expectations, concert attire, etc. A form is included for both student and parent to sign and return to insure that we mutually understand the details of the program. Thank you for taking the time to read and complete the registration materials.

PROGRAM OUTLINE: The OLOM Instrumental Music Program is an opportunity for elementary and middle school students to learn and improve ensemble skills while also increasing their personal skill level. Students have the opportunity to develop musicianship through musical preparation and performance. The emphasis is on improving performance skills and confidence as a musician with relevant musical history, theory, and techniques discussed and studied in class each week. Rehearsals will be held in the music room on Tuesday mornings.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE:

Band - Grades 4-8 – Tuesday, 7:45-8:30 am Strings, Guitar, Piano - Grades 4-8 - Tuesday, 8:40-9:25 am (Classes will rotate times each month so students do not miss the same class all year)

MATERIALS & CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS: Students will need his/her working instrument and

cleaning accessories, music book, assigned sheet music, a pencil, and any other assigned materials on a weekly basis. Method books and folders with all sheet music will be provided. Method books for this year will be Essential Elements Books with interactive website: https://www.essentialelementsinteractive.com

Sheet music (concert songs) should be kept in good condition and students may mark notations on the music in pencil only. Each student is expected to participate in class with a positive attitude and best effort at all times allowing for a encouraging learning environment. Each student is expected to treat themselves, their classmates, the teacher, and the facilities and equipment with respect and consideration.

PRACTICE/HOMEWORK: Students will need to practice at home for a minimum of two hours per week. Practice records verified by the student's parent/guardian will be turned in each Friday. Students must have their part ready not just for performance, but for rehearsal as well. Private lessons are not required, but they are highly recommended. Names of private teachers in the area are available upon request.

CONCERTS/PERFORMANCES: All students are expected to perform at all scheduled performances and concerts as part of class participation. If conflicts arise, please inform the teacher so we can plan accordingly.

CONCERT ATTIRE: Our concert attire reflects the pride we have in our school, music program and ensemble. It is expected that each member of the ensemble will dress appropriately for the special events (i.e. concerts, Festival, etc.) *

COURSE FEE

Installment Plan: (10 payments, September through June): One child - \$85 per installment; Family – \$120 per installment. Those who pay by the monthly installment plan should fill out the form below and return immediately with the first installment. **Semester Plan:** (2 payments October 15th and Feb 1st): One child - \$425 per semester; Family \$600 per semester. Those who pay by the semester plan must send the registration fee now; semester payments are due before October 15th and February 1. Materials Replacement Fee - \$15.
