

Hazardous Waste/Spill Remediation

All schools and facilities within the Orange School System generate hazardous waste. Waste is considered hazardous waste if it has the following characteristics: ignitable, corrosive, reactive, or toxic, or capable of having a harmful effect on human health or the environment.

Environmental Health and Safety manages hazardous waste disposition per federal regulations by ensuring the waste is properly collected from our schools and facilities by an environmental contractor. The environmental contractor will package the hazardous waste into proper containers and transport to a disposal facility.

In addition, Environmental Health and Safety has a contract with an environmental company to remediate any type of spill that may occur at our schools and facilities that has a threat to human health or the environment.

Environmental Health and Safety oversees the contracts and funding for hazardous waste disposal and spill remediation.
