PURPOSE: To present information to the Board of Education about the School-Age Care Programs.

BACKGROUND: The School-Age Care Programs (SAC), operate with the belief that each child is a unique individual. We strive to provide a loving, nurturing, and creative environment for children. We are sensitive to their social, emotional, intellectual, and physical needs. We provide developmentally appropriate programs that focus on the process of learning, while also helping them to enjoy many other successful experiences. We encourage not just learning, but the love of learning. We believe in providing a physical environment that is safe, clean, healthy, and child friendly. Learning Centers are arranged to offer challenging play and learning choices at a range of developmental levels. Learning centers allow children the opportunity to explore, to experience, and most importantly... to succeed.

Operations

The Programs mirror the school district policies and calendar as well as the local school's procedures. The enrichment activities and daily schedule of events are consistent with the philosophy and value system of the school district.

The strength of the program is the experience, expertise, and dedication of our staff. We support the teachers with training, resources, and the freedom to create a unique learning environment. We provide many opportunities for the teachers to share ideas and grow professionally. Our teachers create a caring and nurturing atmosphere that fosters each child's creativity and positive self-image. A variety of academic enhancement and enrichment activities, including homework support, indoor and outdoor games, music, arts and crafts, computer skills, and club activities are planned for children in grades K-5 who are enrolled in the program.

The program staff values people, the children in our care, their parents, and our employees. We continually work to earn the trust placed in us. We strive each day to provide the best educational services possible.

Financial

The School-Age Care Program is an enterprise fund which generates its own revenue through parent fees for services, and through vouchers supported by the N.C. Department of Social Services. SAC operates under the traditional profit and loss approach with the financial goal to be "self supporting." The 2011-2012 financial audit report showed an unrestricted fund balance of \$161,445.00.

Orange County Schools School-Age Care Program (SAC)

OVERVIEW

This report provides an overview of Orange County Schools seven (7) School-age Care Programs (SAC) that are defined as afterschool programs by the school community. These programs include After School, Summer Camp, and Dolphin Camp.

Program Facts

The Orange County Schools' School-Age Care Programs (SAC)/Afterschool Program provides children, ages 5-12, the opportunity to enjoy a wide range of activities. The Afterschool Program occurs every Monday through Friday from 2:20 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., a critical time to engage school-aged children in structured activities. Our aim is to continue the student's education during after school hours by complementing what they learn in school and strengthening their sense of belonging in their communities. Safe, supportive environments for the children who attend our program are created by trained and caring staff.

Each School-Age Care Program provides a comprehensive after school curriculum from fitness to literacy, homework time, and chances for students to get together with friends to have fun. All of our programs are <u>Star</u> <u>Rated and State Licensed</u> (5 STAR) which means parents can feel comfortable knowing their child is in an enriching afterschool environment.

The Orange County Schools' SAC Program is designed to meet the child's social, emotional and physical needs. Based upon play and social experience, the program will complement and not imitate the school day.



NSF Checks - Cash only payments will be accepted if there is an NSF.

Billing- Weeks are only prorated if 3 or more days are missed (ex: week 16, Thanksgiving). All other weeks are billed at the full rate. In the case of inclement weather, Occasional Use - You will be billed monthly for a minimum of 5 days regardless if your child attends or not. Additional days are billed at \$14.00 per day per child. Withdrawal from Program - A two weeks notice is required for withdrawals. The withdrawal form must be submitted to the School Community Relations Office.

Tax Statements for 2012 will be mailed out by January 31, 2013. If you would like to pay additional money for your 2012 tax statement, you Late Pick up fees - are due by the close of the week in which the late fee occurred. Unpaid late pick up fees, child/children will be withdrawn from program. our office will adjust accounts accordingly.
