Orange County Board of Education Resolution for the Use of Qualified School Construction Bond Proceeds

WHEREAS:

The Qualified School Construction Bond (QSCB) Program was established as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA), (Public Law 111-5) effective February 17, 2009.

These interest free bonds must be used for the construction (including new construction), rehabilitation, or repair of a public school, or for land acquisition for such a facility. The maximum term of indebtedness, about 12 years under current market conditions which are subject to change, is set by the U.S. Treasury Department so that the local government's obligation to repay the present value terms will be 50 percent of the borrowed amount.

The U.S. Treasury Department has allocated for 2009 the authority to issue QSCBs in North Carolina in the face value amount of \$275,772,000. The ARRA includes a provision that will allow for a second issuance of bonds in 2010. QSCBs must be issued by December 31, 2010 and the proceeds must be spent within three years of issue date.

BE IT, THEREFORE, RESOLVED by the Orange County Board of Education, as follows:

that the QSCB proceeds allocated to Orange County Schools will be used for the renovation of the projects identified in QSCB Application for Authorization, dated March 7, 2012...
