PURPOSE: To provide the Orange County Board of Education the annual report on the SAT and ACT results as well as a five year analysis of student performance on both of these college entrance exam measures.

BACKGROUND: The results of these tests were released in August (ACT) and September (SAT) this year. The 2013 ACT and SAT results show that the school district's composite scores remain above both the state and national averages.

2013 SAT Results:

The District SAT composite score of 1038 was well above the state (1001) and the national (1010) averages. Orange High School showed a decrease in their Composite score from 1011 in 2011-12 to 1001 in 2012-13. Cedar Ridge also showed a decrease in their Composite score from 1085 in 2011-12 to 1077 in 2012-13. Both high schools offer an SAT preparatory class as an elective. Students from both high schools are able to access a web-based software program (Study Island) to assist in their preparation for the SAT/ACT.

2013 ACT Results:

The District Composite score of 19.4 on the graduating seniors report of the ACT was above the state score of 18.7. Orange High School showed a decrease on the Composite score from 23.3 in 2011-12 to 18.4 in 2012-13. Cedar Ridge showed an increase in their Composite score from 20.6 in 2011-12 to 20.7 in 2012-13.

2013 Statewide ACT Administration:

This is the second year that all juniors participated in the ACT exam. Results from the state analysis by district for 11th graders showed Orange County Schools ranking 13th in the state for percentage of students meeting benchmark percents on a total of 4 subgroups (English, Reading, Math and Science). The school district continues to offer support to help students prepare for college admissions tests.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:


A prorated amount of \$7,000 (a portion of the Study Island software costs) were spent to provide support for SAT/ACT preparation for both high schools.

RECOMMENDATION: The Superintendent recommends that the Board of Education receive the 2013 SAT/ACT test results for information.




Orange County Schools Cedar Ridge High School SAT Scores - Composite 2008-09 to 2012-13




Orange County Schools Orange High School SAT Scores - Composite 2008-09 to 2012-13




Orange County Schools Cedar Ridge High School SAT Scores - Grand Composite 2008-09 to 2012-13



Orange County Schools Orange High School SAT Scores - Grand Composite 2008-09 to 2012-13




Orange County Schools SAT Scores - Composite 2008-09 to 2012-13




Orange County Schools SAT Scores – Grand Composite 2008-09 to 2012-13
