Class credits

- ► In order topass a class, you must get a 60 or above on your final grade!
- ► Every time you pass a class you get awarded one credit which counts towards your graduating credits.
- Credits are used to determine your grade level and graduation status.

Credits for Promotion

- ▷ In order to be promoted to the next grade level you have to have a certain number of credits at the end of the school year...
 - **9th to 10th** 6 credits
 - **10th to 11th** 12 credits
 - 11th to 12th- 20 credits

Graduation - 28 credits and all requirements met.

Graduation

► In order to graduate, you must have 28 credits AND pass all graduation requirement classes by the end of your senior year.

- → All students in grade 10 take the pre-ACT
- ▷ All students in grade 11 take the ACT
 State-mandated
- > Student are automatically enrolled
- Students can use/submit the results to these test for colleges and universities
