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**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this agenda item is to report to the Board of Education the donation of a gift to Orange High School and to provide the opportunity for the Board to accept the gift on behalf of the school district.

**BACKGROUND:** The Orange High School Dug Out Club has requested to make a donation of a bench for the baseball dugout valued at \$500.

In accordance with Board Policy #8220 Gifts and Bequests,

*"The Superintendent will evaluate any offers of gifts or bequests that are not revenues or gifts of nominal value. The superintendent will consider the gift's suitability, and safety hazards and costs to maintain the gift and will make a recommendation to the board. . . . The board will decide whether to accept the gift on behalf of the school district."*

Furthermore, *"The superintendent or designee must approve the design, location and construction material before the installation of major gifts that will become a permanent part of the school facility or grounds..."*

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:** There is no financial impact to the district associated with this item.

**RECOMMENDATION:** The Superintendent recommends the Board of Education accept the gift on behalf of the district of a bench to be placed in the dugout at Orange High School.
