SCHOOL BUS HEAT SAFETY MEASURES

As we enter the warmer months, we want to ensure that our students stay safe and comfortable while traveling on the school bus. Below are the measures we have implemented to protect students from the heat.

Ventilation:

- All windows and roof vents will be opened to increase airflow.
- All fans on the bus will be turned on to circulate air.

Seating Arrangements:

- Students will be seated on the opposite side of the bus from the sun to minimize direct sunlight exposure.
- When possible, students will be seated one per seat to maximize space and comfort.

Hydration:

- Students are encouraged to fill their water bottles before departure.
- The bus will stop for water breaks mid-trip as needed to ensure students stay hydrated.

Appropriate Dress:

- Students should remove jackets and extra clothing. Light and breathable clothing is recommended for bus travel.
