

A.C. Corcoran Uniform Dress Code Policy

All students are required to follow A.C. Corcoran's dress code policy, as outlined below. Students are expected to be dressed according to the uniform standards at all times when school is in session. The Principal and/or Principal's designee may make exceptions to the uniform policy for special events, such as picture day, and may allow a different standard for themed activities or other school celebrations. Clothing worn on dress down days and other special events must adhere to the CCSD Policy JICA- Student Dress/Uniforms. The dress code expectations are outlined in this policy.

Students should arrive at school daily in full school uniform.

Tops

1. Students must wear plain solid-colored shirts with a collar. Mock turtlenecks and turtlenecks are acceptable.
2. Shirts may have school-approved logos.
3. Shirts may not exceed one (1) size larger or smaller than necessary as determined by the principal and/or the principal's designee.
4. Shirts must be tucked in (exceptions may be made for CD and kindergarten students as needed by the principal and/or the principal's designee).
5. White or black t-shirts (long or short sleeves) may be worn under uniform shirts.
6. Students may wear solid-colored, unhooded sweaters or sweatshirts over school uniforms. **No hooded garments will be allowed.**
7. Sweaters, sweatshirts, coats and jackets with hoods are not permitted to be worn while indoors.

Bottoms

1. Bottoms must be a solid color, and shall be solid khaki, black or navy.
2. Jeans are not permitted. The principal and/or the principal's designee may make exceptions for school-approved dress down days.
3. Bottoms must be free of graphics and embroidery. With the exception of small labels, bottoms may not have insignias, words or pictures.
4. Shorts, skirts, skorts, and jumpers shall be modest and of sufficient length. The length of these articles of clothing shall be no shorter than three (3) inches above the top of the knee when standing.
5. Cargo-style pants or shorts, leggings, jeggings, and yoga style pants are not permitted.
6. Clothing may not exceed one (1) size larger than necessary as determined by . Baggy or sagging pants or shorts are not permitted. "Low rise" clothing is not permitted. Pants, shorts, and skirts must be worn at the natural waistline.
7. Belts must be worn if pants, skirts, skorts or shorts have belt loops (exceptions may be made by the principal and/or the principal's designee). Belt buckles must not be oversized, computerized or have any writing that is considered offensive.

Shoes

1. Health laws require students to wear shoes at all times. To prevent accidents, students should avoid wearing shoes that slide off easily.
2. Laces on shoes or sneakers must be tied.
3. Flip flops, Crocs, slides, slippers (including slipper boots) and all types of backless sandals are not permitted.
4. Heelies and other footwear with wheels are not permitted.
5. Open-toed are acceptable, but not recommended. All shoes must have a back or ankle strap.

Dress Down Days

- Dress down days must adhere to the CCSD JICA Policy Student Dress/Uniform. Please read these expectations in their entirety.
- Faculty and staff will not be able to deliver clothes should you or your student forget to dress down on permitted days. This is a disturbance to the teaching and learning environment.
