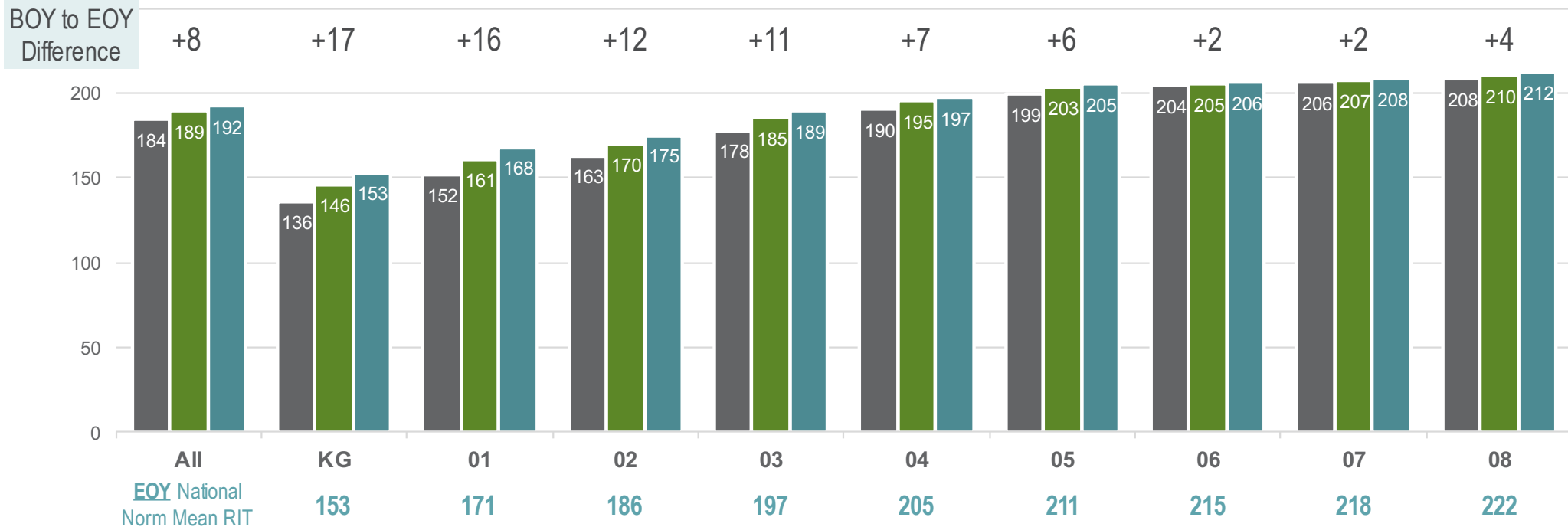

Average RIT Score by Grade Level



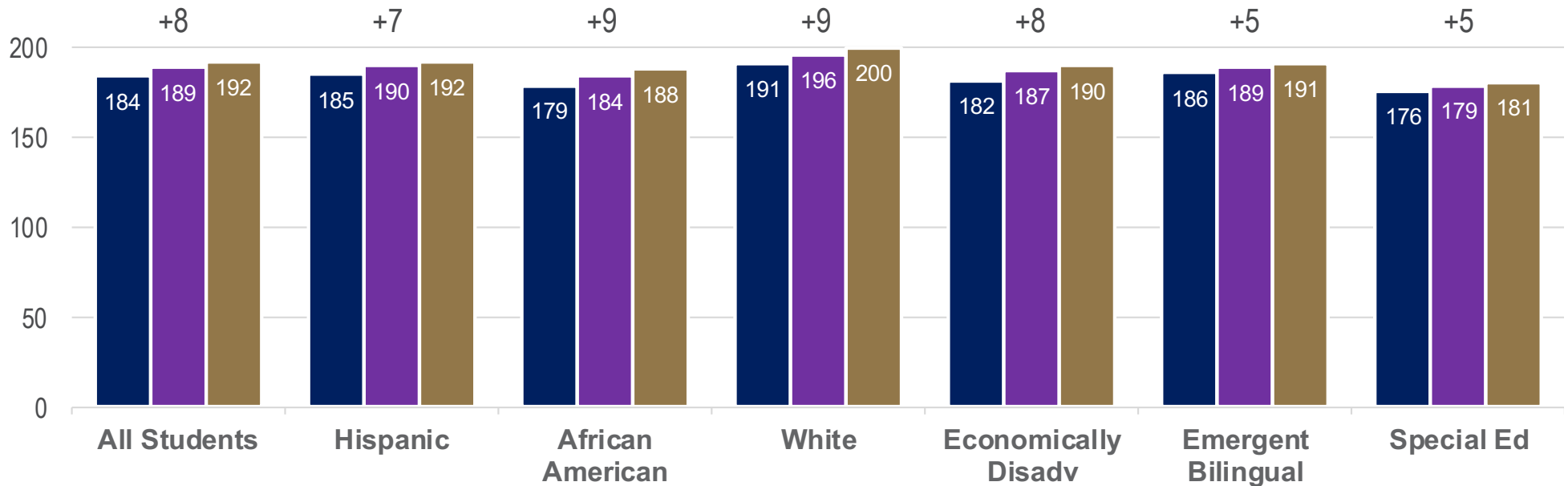

Average RIT Score by Student Group



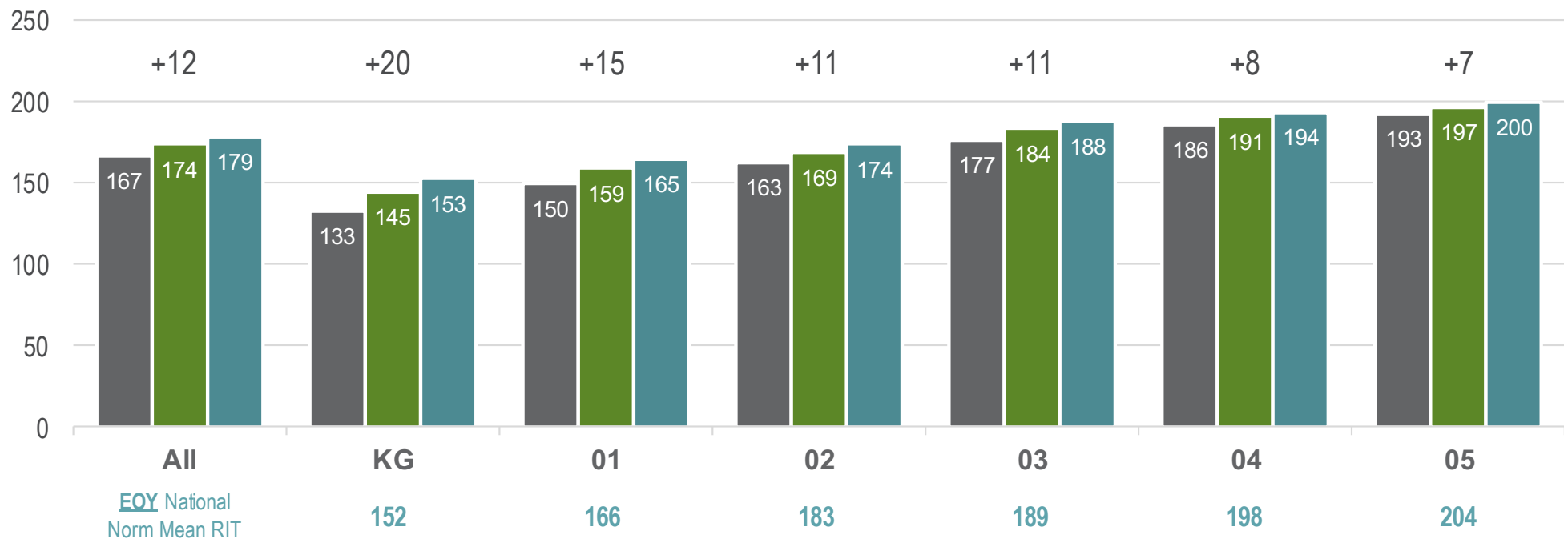

Average RIT Score by Grade Level



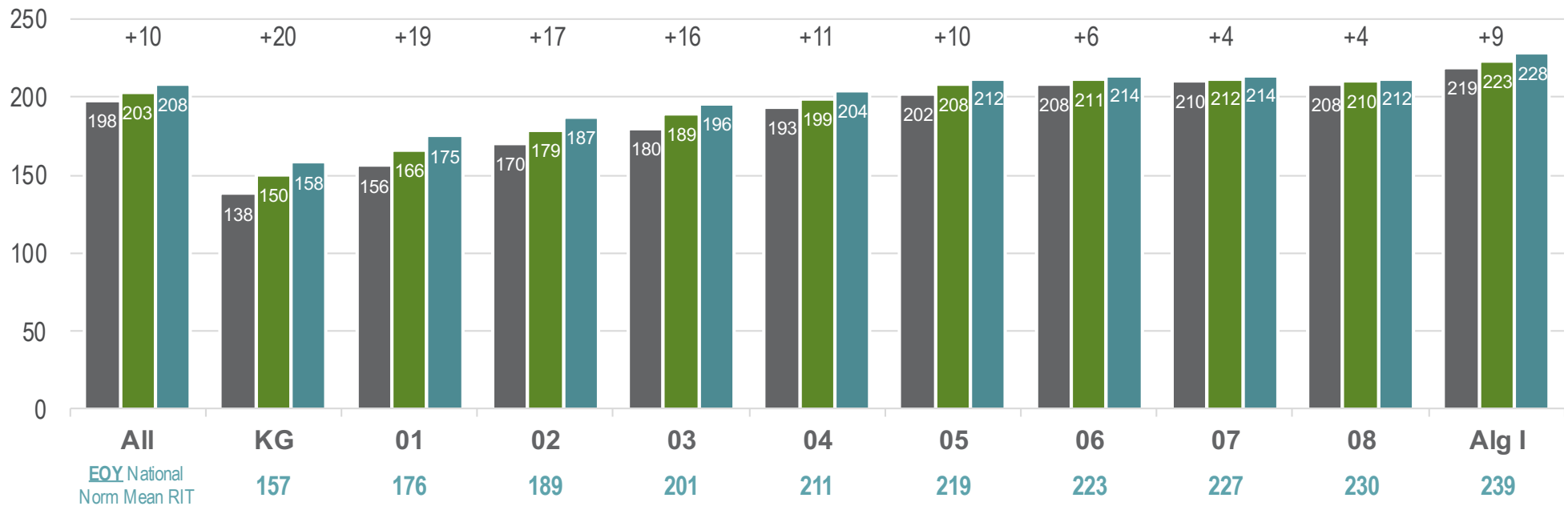

Average RIT Score by Grade Level



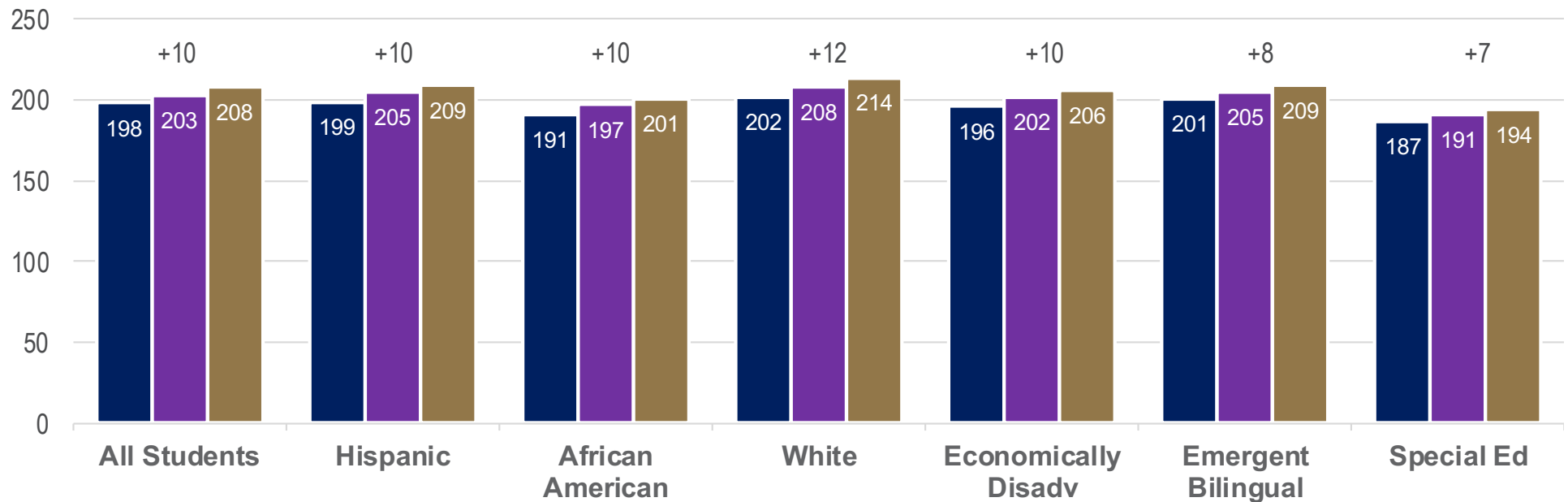

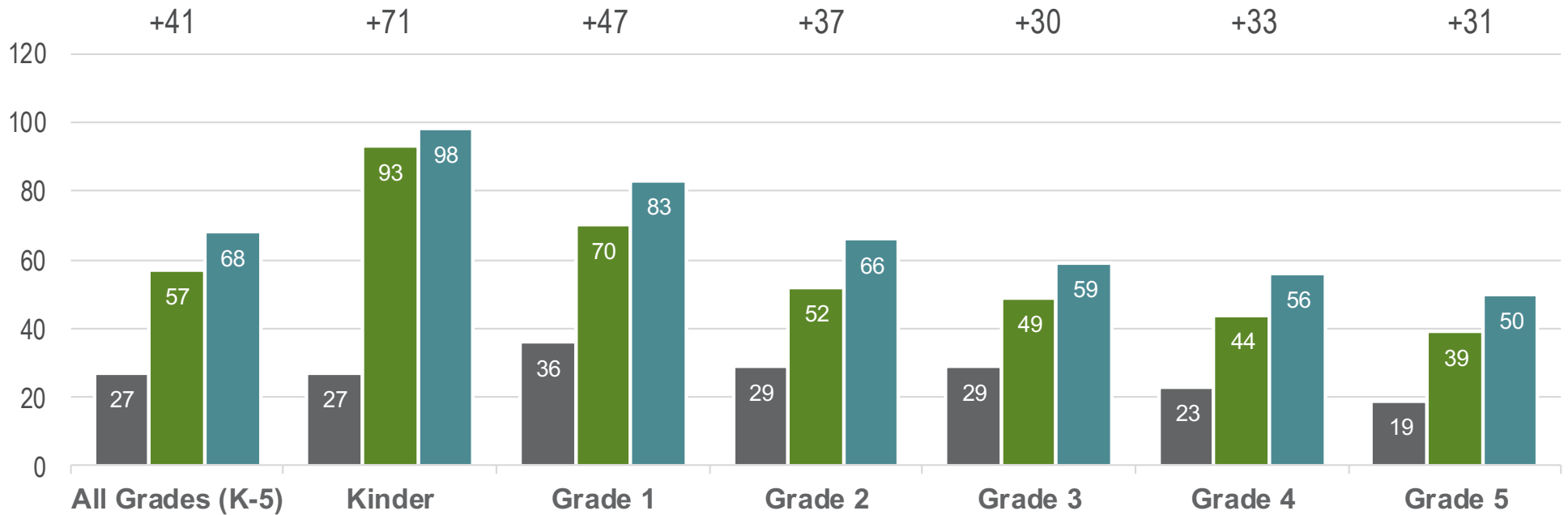
Lexia Learning Reading Grades K-5

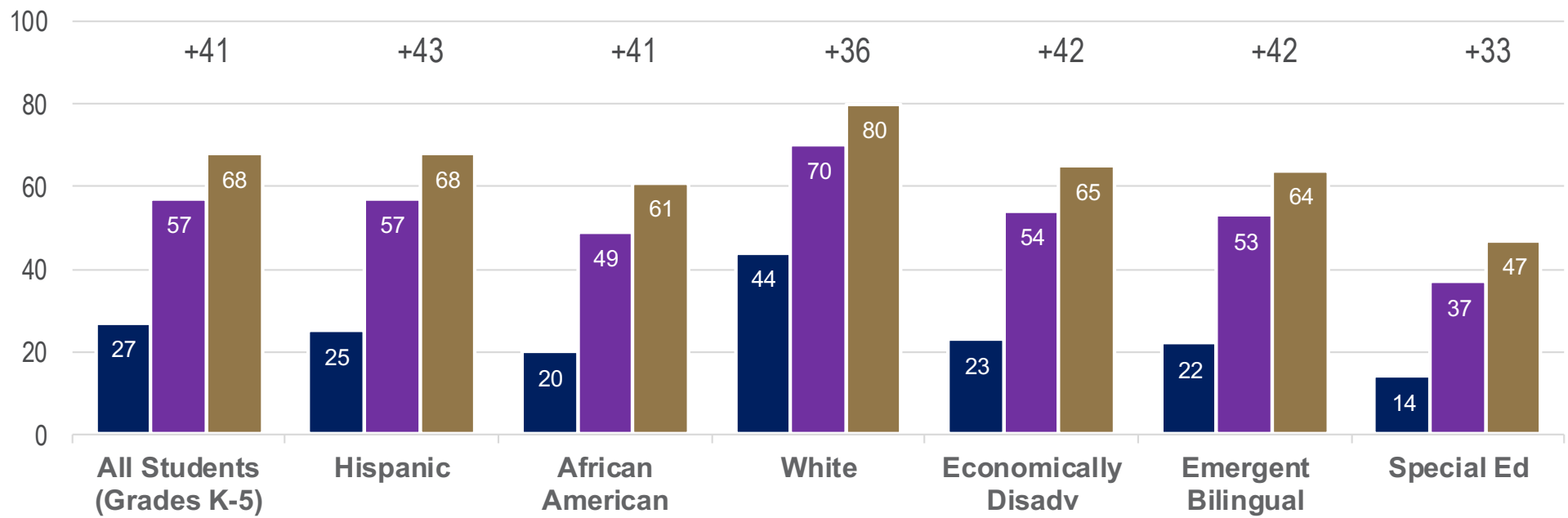
Percent of Students At or Above Grade Level in Core 5 by Grade Level

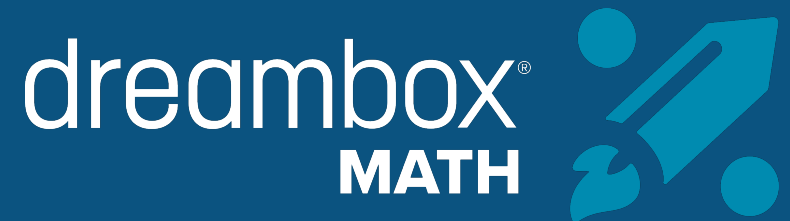


Percent of Students At or Above Grade Level in Core 5 by Student Group

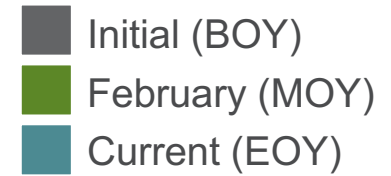

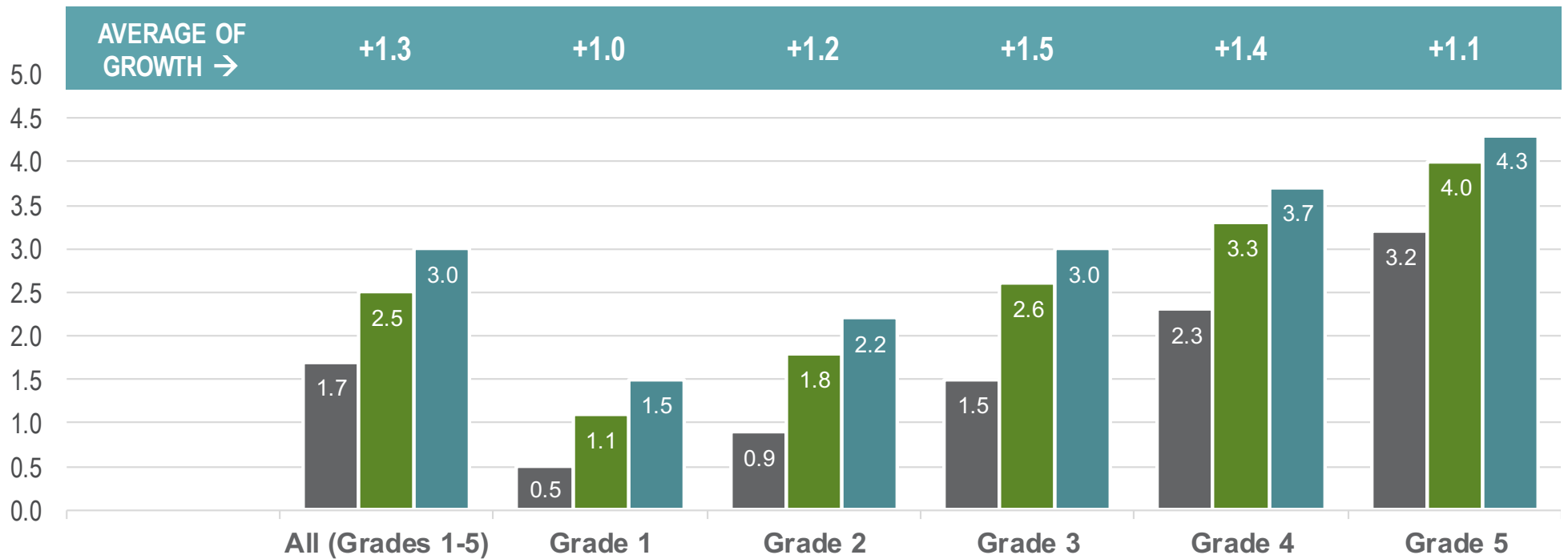

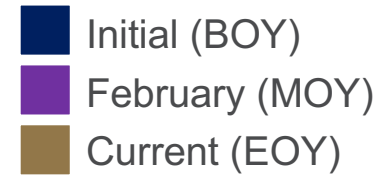
DreamBox Math Growth



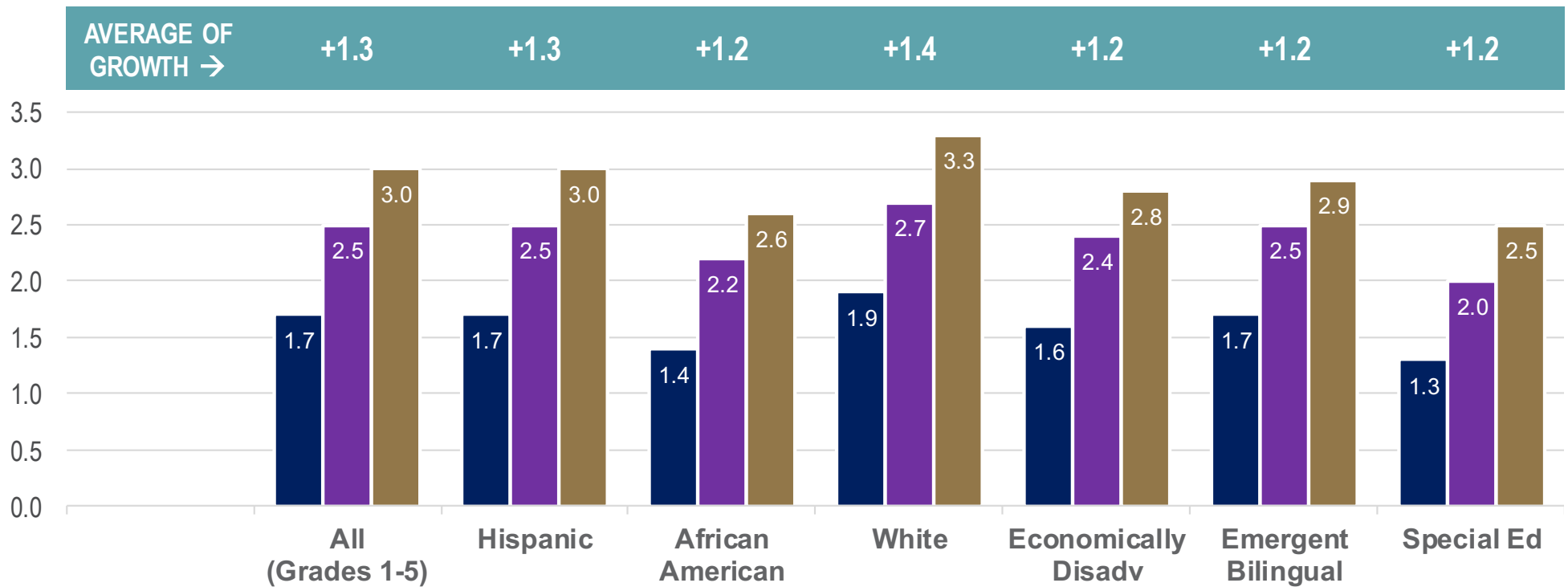
Average DreamBox Grade Level Standings by Grade Level

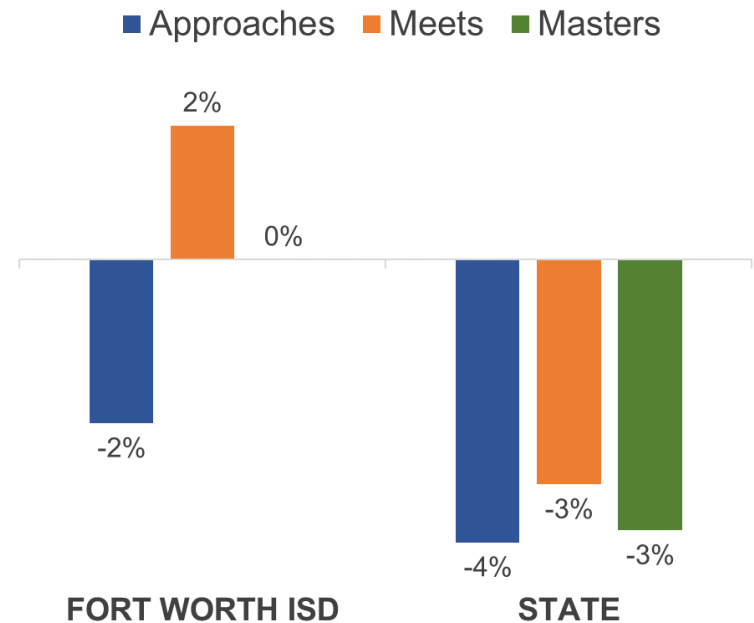

Percentile Point Change from 2023 to 2024



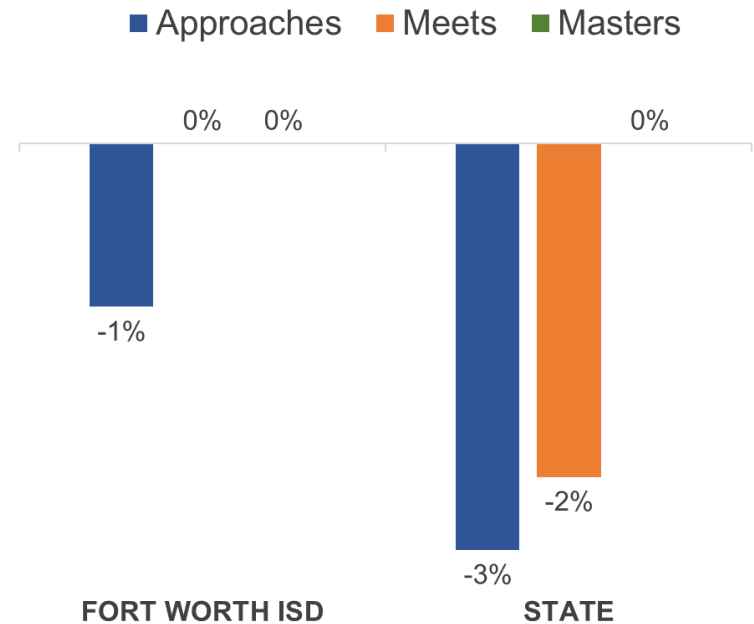

Percentile Point Change from 2023 to 2024



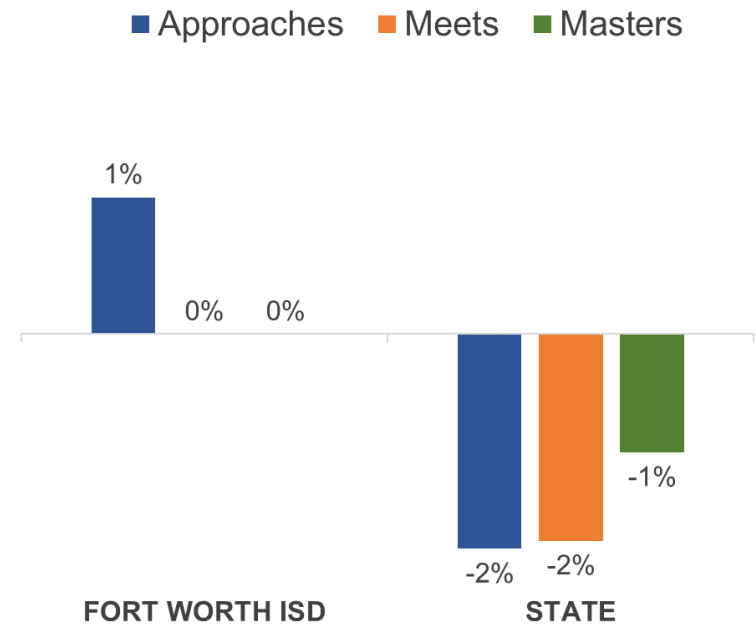

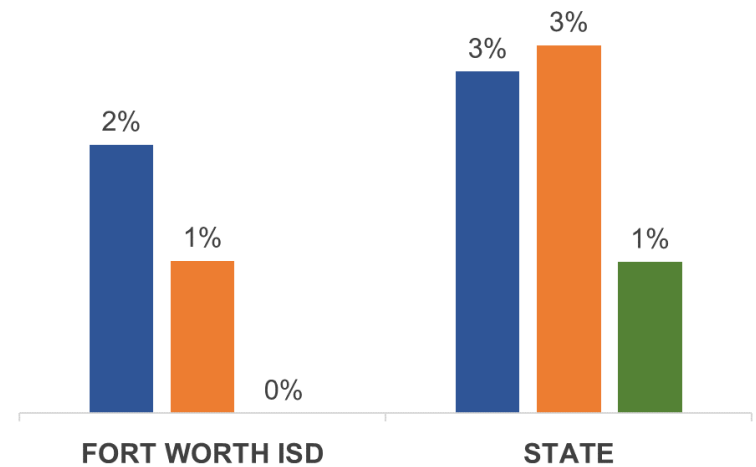

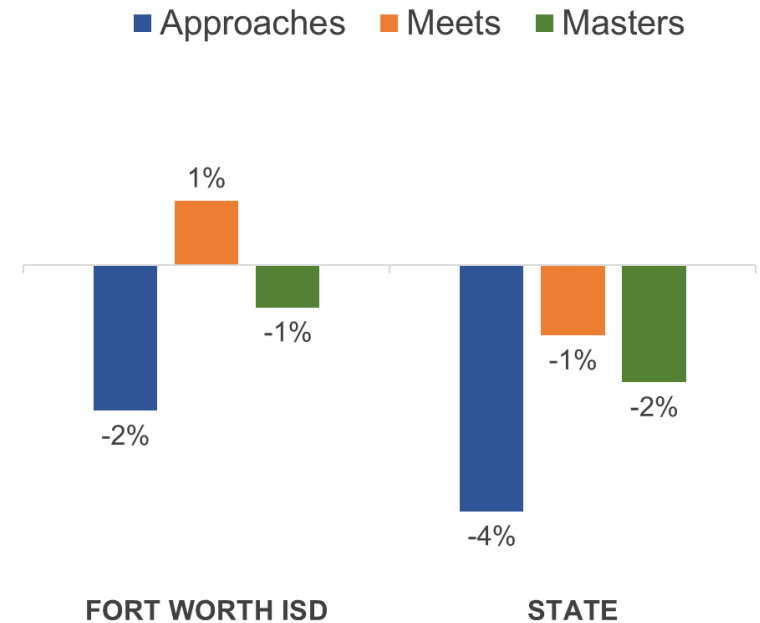

Percentile Point Change from 2023 to 2024



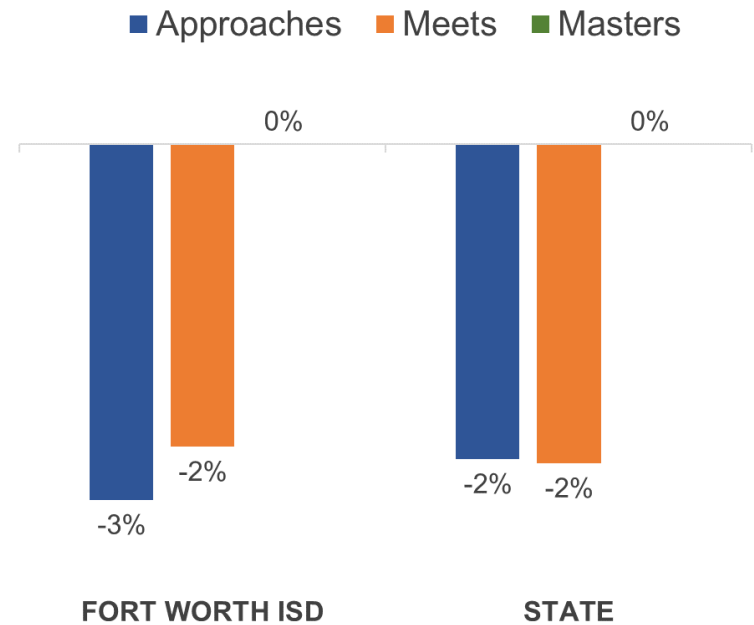

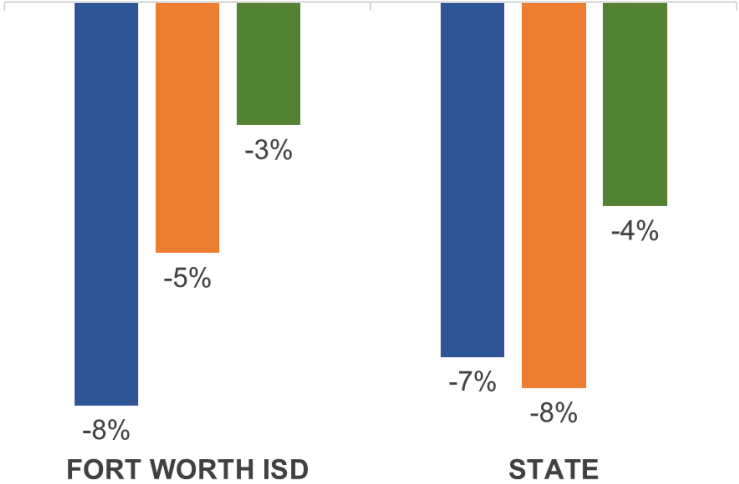

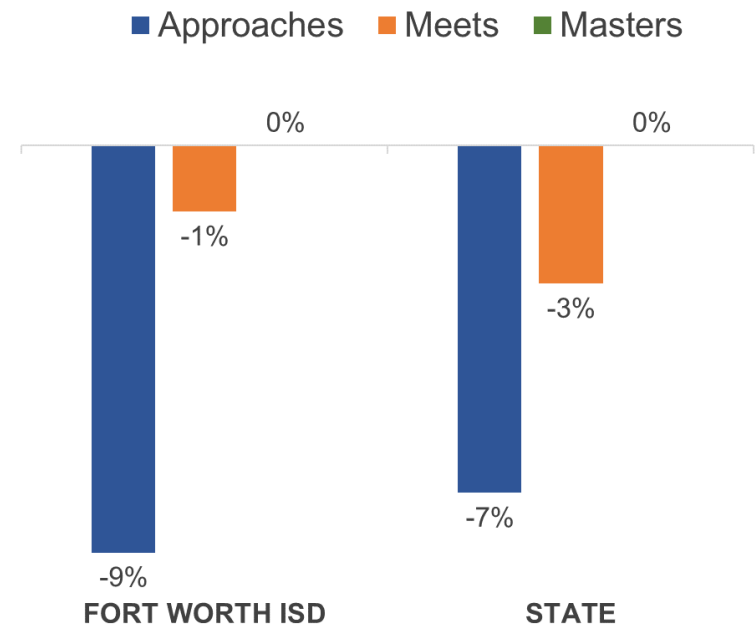

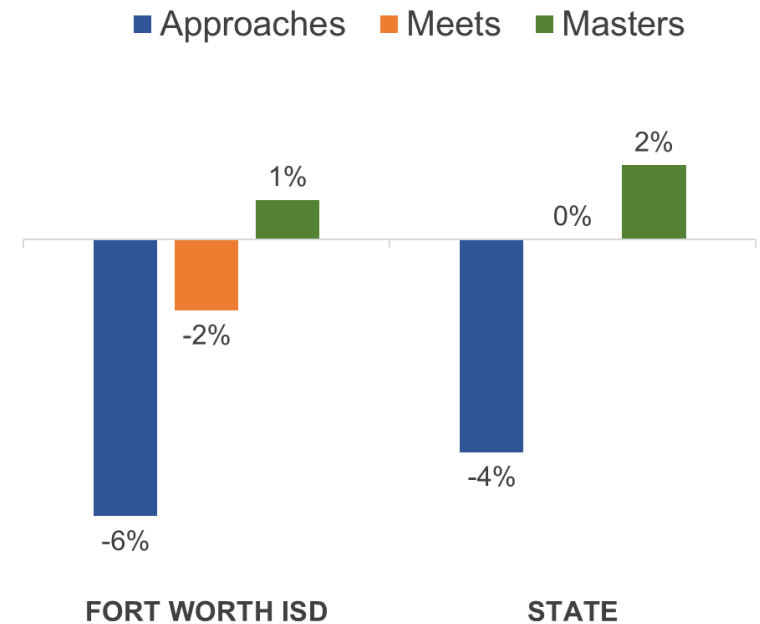

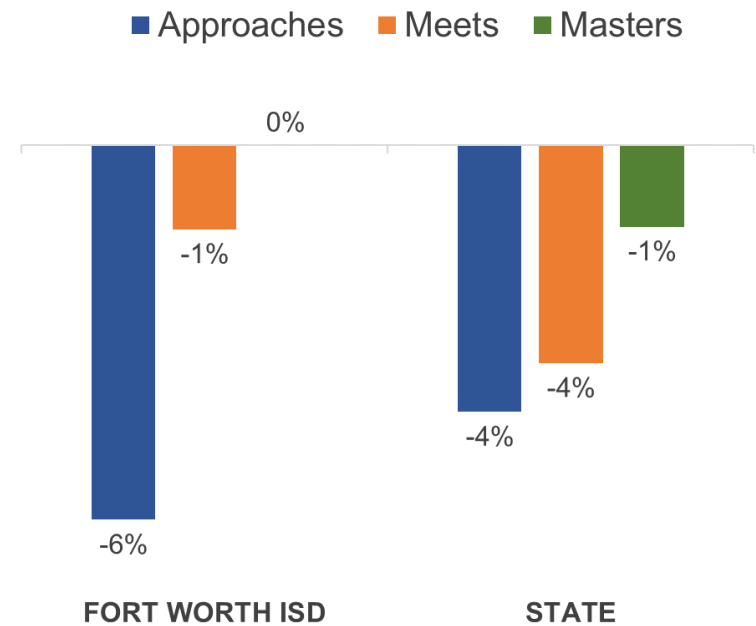

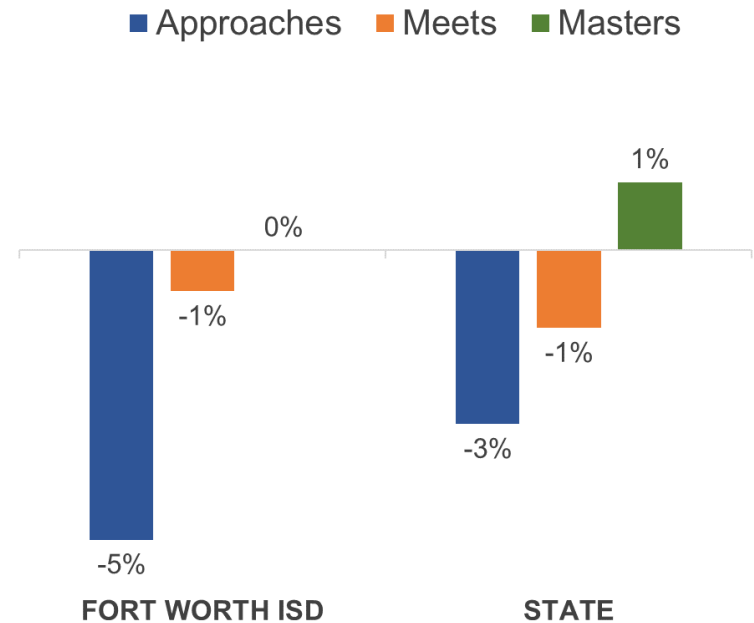

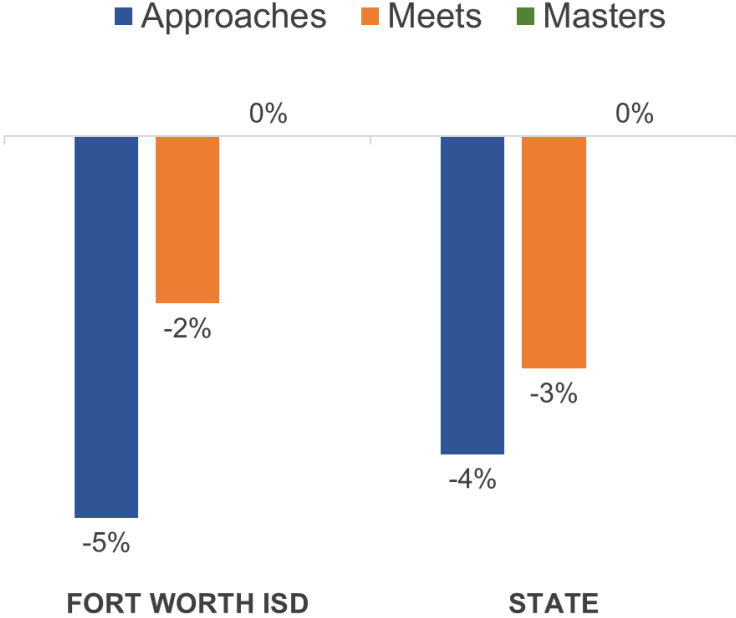

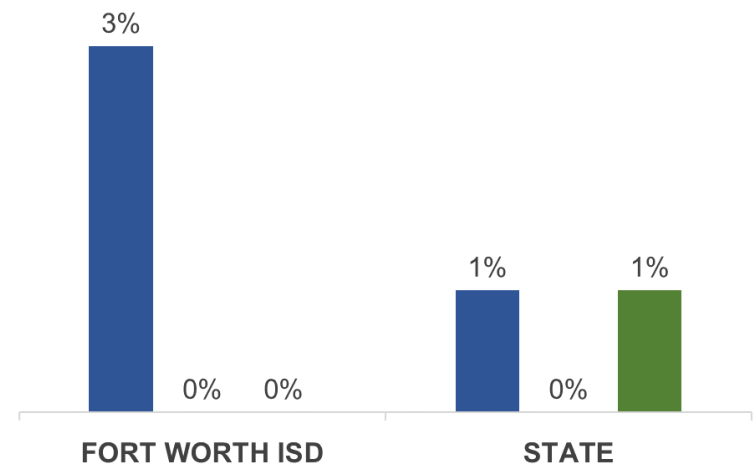

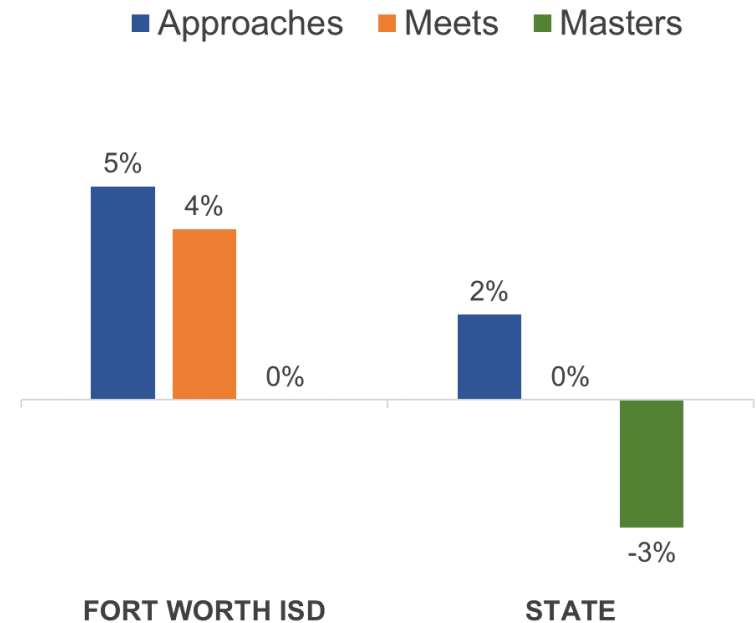

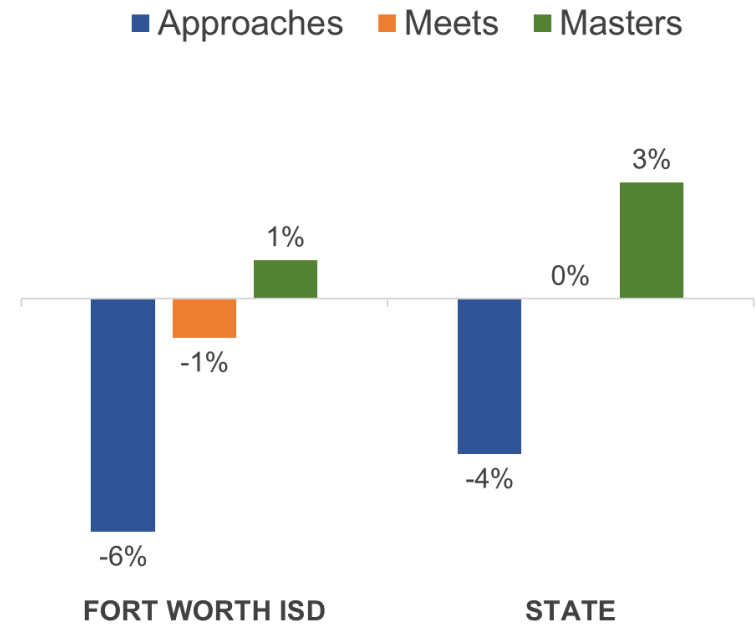

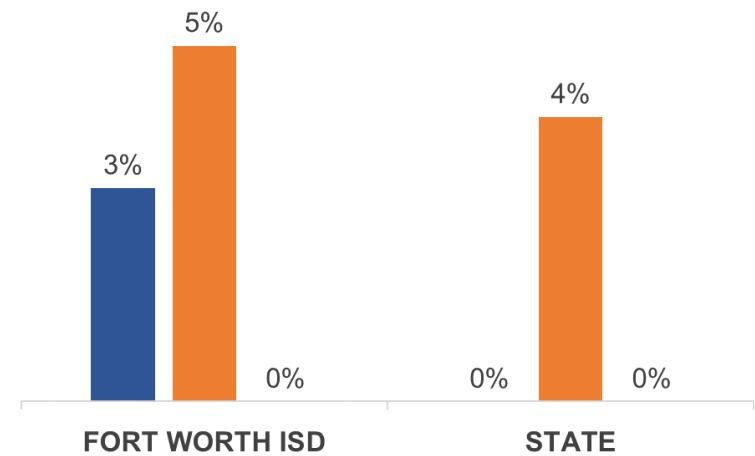

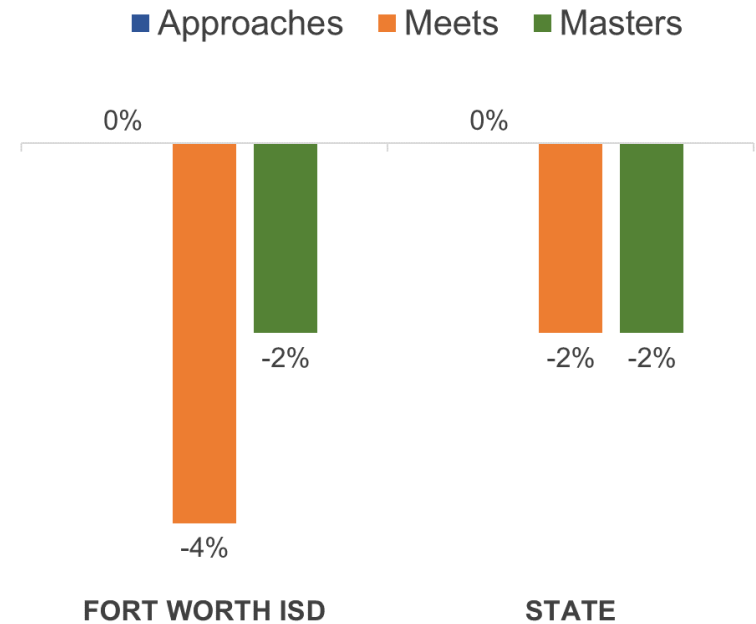

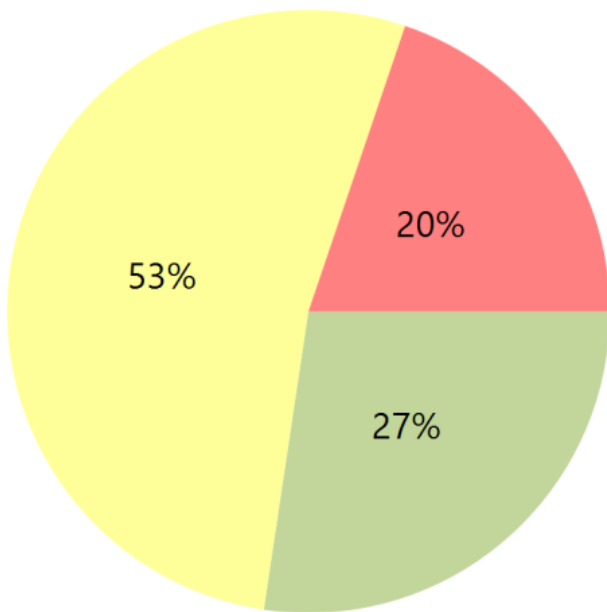

CCMR Over Time



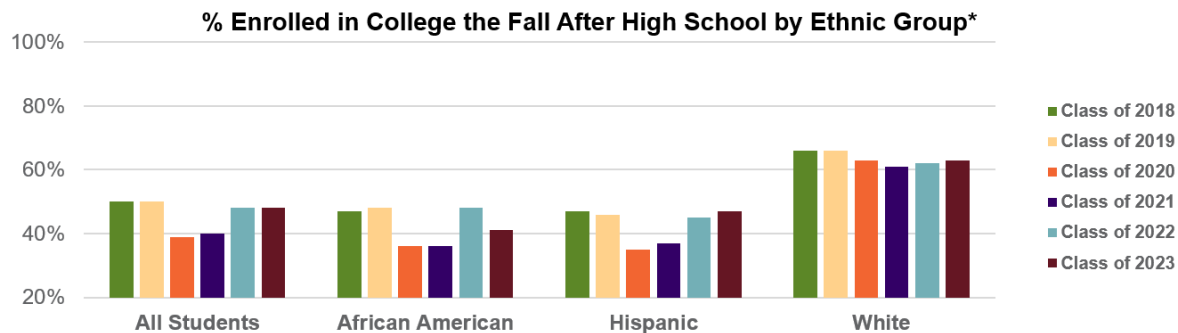
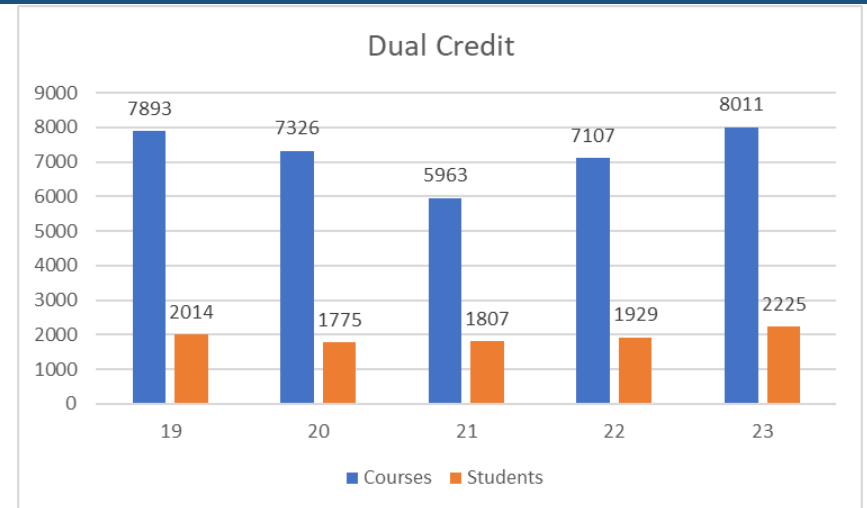
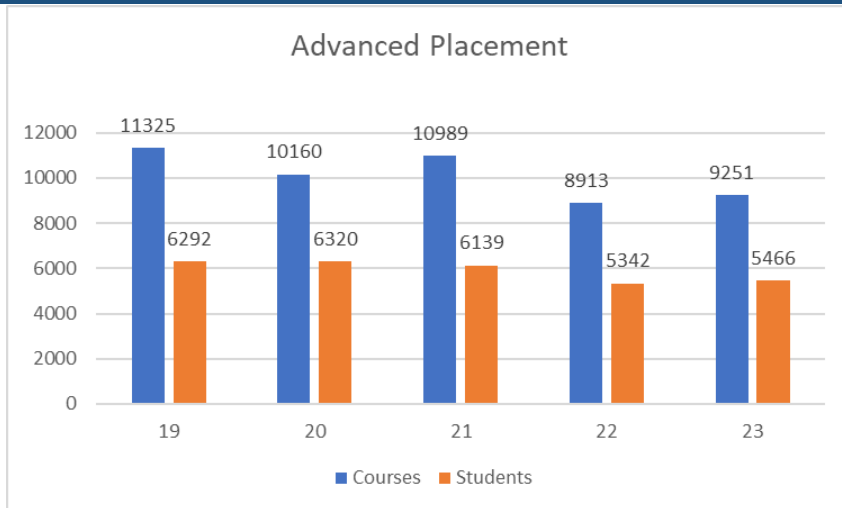

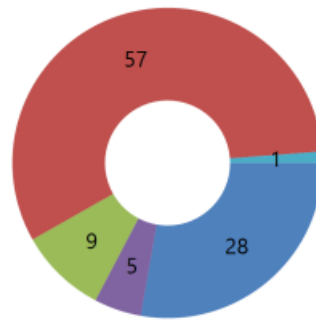
