The Board of Trustees' meetings are open to in-person attendance.

Public Comments: This is the time for members of the public to address the Board regarding the special business items on the Agenda. Pursuant to Government Code 54956 and Education Code 35144, no business other than the business listed on the agenda can be considered at special meetings. Individual speakers shall be allowed three (3) minutes to address the Board on each agenda item. Please note that speaking time cannot be delegated to another person. The Board shall limit the total time for public input on each item to 20 minutes. With Board consent, the President may increase or decrease the time allowed for public comment, depending on the topic and the number of persons wishing to address the Board.

The Board understands that the First Amendment provides strong protection for speech. However, the Board expects that all speech and expression will comport with norms of civil behavior on district grounds, in district facilities, during district activities or events, and in the use of district electronic/digital systems and platforms.

Civil behavior is polite, courteous, and reasonable behavior which is respectful to others and includes integrity, honesty, acceptance, timeliness, dependability, observance of laws and rules, and effective communication.

In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, for those requiring special assistance to access the Board meeting room, to access written documents being discussed at the Board meeting, or to otherwise participate at Board meetings, please contact the Office of the Superintendent at 916-770-8850 for assistance. NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The Dry Creek Joint Elementary School District will hold a public hearing on July 16, 2024, at 6:00 p.m., to gather public input regarding draft trustee area maps.

The Dry Creek Joint Elementary School District's Board of Trustees is currently elected under an "at-large" election system, where Board members are elected by voters of the entire District. On April 18, 2024, the Board adopted Resolution No. 2023-16, signaling its intent to transition to by-trustee area elections. In a by-trustee area election system, each Board member must reside within the designated trustee area boundary and is elected only by the voters in that trustee area.

On or around May 28, 2024, the District published "draft" trustee area maps for the Board and public's consideration. On June 11, 2024, and July 9, 2024, the District published additional "draft" trustee area maps for the Board and public's consideration. The maps were published on the District's website: <https://drycreekschoolsus.finalsite.com/about-us/board-of-trustees-districting>.

On June 4, 2024 and June 18, 2024, the Board held a public hearing to receive community input on the proposed trustee area maps. On July 16, 2024, at 6:00 p.m., the Board will hold a third public hearing at the Dry Creek District Education Center Community Room (located at 8849 Cook Riolo Rd., Roseville, CA) to gather additional input on the composition of potential trustee areas pursuant to Elections Code section 10010, prior to taking action to adopt a chosen map. The public is invited to participate and make comments during the public hearing.
