Night before



- Set out clothes
- Pack backpack
- Pack lunch and a cold water bottle
- Print out "First Day" signs for pictures
- Set bedtime a little earlier than normal
- Set an alarm (or two!)
- Charge phones and cameras
- Read a "Back to School" story
- Ask your child what they are excited about

First day



- Get up earlier than normal
- Have a healthy breakfast at home or school
- Take "First Day" photos
- Finish packing bags
- Arrive a little early
- Follow instructions for drop-off and pick-up
- Try to stay calm and reassuring
- Remind your child of what to expect after the school day

Prep for a Successful Year

Children moving on to middle school (or moving to a new campus in general) may have some concerns about memorizing the layout of their new school, the names of their teachers, and how much time they have between passing periods. We highly encourage attending Meet the Teacher events to help students feel more prepared, and in turn, less nervous.

Talk Through Anxiety

While the start of a new school year is exciting, it can also bring up feelings of nervousness or anxiety. Consider talking to your child(ren) about their expectations, and express confidence that as they face their fears, they will become more confident in time!

Take "TW0"

Start the school year strong (and keep backpacks clutter-free) by having your child(ren) take two minutes before starting homework to organize their bags, folders and any loose papers.

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL Tips for Parents & Guardians

Assure your child they will be safe, have fun and there will be lots of teachers and staff around to help. Put on a brave face, model for your child that school is a fun and safe environment, and that you are confident they will have a good first day. Have a plan for saying goodbye, hug, and then it's time to leave and school to start.





Remember, your kids are growing up--middle school is NOT scary. **We will take excellent care of them!**

Relax! Smile! **Take a picture or two because it is really fun to compare first and last days throughout the years!** If you are stressed, try not to let your children see it...do your best for their first day to be fun, special and stress-free!





Model kindness for your child. There are a lot of people on campus, and our systems can take a few days to get used to. This can create frustration, but rise above it and show your child that even though things may not go perfectly, or that people are getting used to things, **we still spread kindness.**

Send your child to school with all of the supplies they need. Make sure that your students are independent with all of their supplies. **Take those first day pictures!**

Adjust schedules early

Give you and your child(ren) time to "reset" for the school year. Adjust summer vs. school year sleep schedules and screen time parameters at least one week before school starts to help provide a smooth start to the school year.

Prep for lunch time

If you have a child bringing a lunch for the first time, consider having them practice opening and closing lunch containers at home. If they struggle in the cafeteria, they can always raise their hand for help.

Establish a homework routine

Discuss a routine for homework ahead of the school year, so everyone has clear expectations before school begins. This could be as soon as they get home from school, after dinner, or some other time that works for your student(s) and family.

Create a family calendar

The school year brings with it a variety of events - from parent teacher organization fundraisers to extracurriculars and sports! A family calendar will not only help you plan, but it can help keep everyone on the same page and promote good time management.

SAFETY TIPS FOR BUS RIDERS

AT THE BUS STOP

Arrive at the stop early, and stand at least 6 feet (or three giant steps!) away from the curb while waiting for the bus.

GETTING ON & OFF THE BUS

Students should always wait for the bus to come to a complete stop before boarding and deboarding. Cross in **front** of the bus, and make eye contact with the driver. Students should **never** cross the street behind a bus.


SEATBELTS, EVERYONE!
