Dear County Office of Education Chief Business Officials:

## **2021–22 Fourth Quarter Lottery Apportionment**

The State Controller's Office (SCO) distributed the 2021–22 fourth quarter Lottery apportionment on September 30, 2022. The total apportioned to county offices of education, school districts, and charter schools is \$387,161,063.10. Local educational agencies (LEAs) will receive \$185,504,931.05 or \$30.06 (\$30.059842978) per unit of average daily attendance (ADA) for the unrestricted lottery apportionment and \$201,656,132.05 or \$32.68 (\$32.677037791) per unit of ADA for the Proposition 20 lottery apportionment this quarter.
