SUBJECT: 2022-23 1st QUARTER LOTTERY APPORTIONMENT

The 2022-23 First Quarter Lottery apportionment was distributed by the State Controller's Office and deposited into the districts' accounts on January 4, 2023. The total amount being apportioned to K-12 school districts, charter schools, community colleges and county offices of education is \$70.28 per unit of average daily attendance (ADA) for unrestricted lottery apportionment and \$0 for the Proposition 20 apportionment. Lottery is funded based on current year Annual ADA but is initially allocated using the prior year's Annual ADA multiplied by the factor of 1.04446.
