SUBJECT: 2020-21 4th QUARTER LOTTERY APPORTIONMENT

The 2020-21 fourth quarter lottery apportionment was distributed by the State Controller's Office and deposited into the districts' accounts on September 30, 2021. The total amount being apportioned to K-12 school districts, charter schools, community colleges and county offices of education is \$28.86 per unit of average daily attendance (ADA) for unrestricted lottery apportionment and \$31.51 for the Proposition 20 apportionment. Lottery is funded based on current year Annual ADA but is initially allocated using the prior year's Annual ADA multiplied by the factor of 1.04446.
