SUBJECT: 2018-19 4th QUARTER LOTTERY APPORTIONMENT

The 2018-19 fourth quarter lottery apportionment was distributed by the State Controller's Office and deposited in to the districts' accounts on September 30, 2019. The total amount being apportioned to K-12 school districts, charter schools, community colleges and county offices of education is \$26.13 per unit of average daily attendance (ADA) for unrestricted lottery apportionment and \$27.98 for the Proposition 20 apportionment. Lottery is funded based on the prior year annual ADA of the LEA multiplied by the factor of 1.04446.

A final lottery revenue adjustment is included in this fourth quarter apportionment. The adjustment reflects additional 2017-18 lottery revenue that is available for distribution. The additional revenue released for 2017-18 consists of \$0.173933643 per ADA in unrestricted lottery funding and \$0.190100973 per ADA in restricted Proposition 20 lottery funding.

This fourth quarter lottery apportionment includes prior-year adjustments for 2017-18.
