SUBJECT: 2019/20 1st QUARTER LOTTERY APPORTIONMENT

The 2019/20 first quarter lottery apportionment was distributed by the State Controller's Office and deposited into the districts' accounts on January 3, 2020. The total amount being apportioned to K-12 school districts, charter schools, community colleges and county offices of education is \$50.19 per unit of average daily attendance (ADA) for unrestricted lottery apportionment and \$0 for the Proposition 20 apportionment. Lottery is funded based on the prior year annual ADA of the LEA multiplied by the factor of 1.04446.
