Fiscal Year 2023–24**

This apportionment, in the amount of \$6,488,776, is made from federal funds provided to the state under Title I, Part D, Subpart 2, Prevention and Intervention Programs for Children and Youth Who Are Neglected, Delinquent, or At-Risk, of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (Public Law 114–95). Title I, Part D, Subpart 2 funds are apportioned to local educational agencies (LEAs) to provide programs that serve children and youth who are in locally operated correctional facilities or are attending community day programs for delinquent children and youth, and to provide assistance to children and youth who are neglected or at-risk of dropping out of school. Warrants will be mailed to each county treasurer approximately three weeks from the date of this letter.
