This apportionment, in the amount of \$4,009,143, is made from federal funds provided to the state under Title I, Part D, Subpart 2, Prevention and Intervention Programs for Children and Youth Who Are Neglected, Delinquent, or At-Risk, of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (Public Law 114–95). Title I, Part D, Subpart 2 funds are apportioned to local educational agencies (LEAs) to provide programs that serve children and youth who are in locally-operated correctional facilities or are attending community day programs for delinquent children and youth, and to provide assistance to children and youth who are neglected or at-risk of dropping out of school. Warrants will be mailed to each county treasurer approximately three weeks from the date of this Notice.
