This apportionment, in the amount of \$32,678,543, is made from federal funds provided to the state under Title I, Part A, of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (ESEA), as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) (Public Law 114–95). Section 1003 of the ESSA provides grants to local educational agencies (LEAs) to serve schools implementing comprehensive support and improvement (CSI) activities. Warrants will be mailed to each county treasurer approximately three weeks from the date of this Notice.

Information about the program, allocation and apportionments, grant award identification, applicable federal rules and regulations, and the grant award period are posted on the California Department of Education (CDE) Funding Results page at <https://www.cde.ca.gov/fg/fo/r14/csilea21result.asp>.

Only those LEAs that submitted the 2021–22 ESSA CSI LEA Application for Funding to the California Department of Education (CDE) are included in this apportionment. The first apportionment is equal to 25 percent of the LEA allocation. The amount paid to each LEA is based on a formula that takes into consideration the number of schools eligible for CSI, statewide. Apportionments for subsequent grant performance periods will be based on cumulative expenditures less prior cumulative payments, not to exceed each LEAs allocation.

County superintendents were notified of this apportionment by email sent to their CDEfisc email addresses. The CDE requests that the email be forwarded to all school districts and charter schools in the county that met the criteria for CSI.
