



### **SHS ELAC**

The SHS English Learner Advisory Committee is a school-level committee comprised of parents, staff, and community members designated to advise school officials on English learner programs and services.

The SHS ELAC is responsible for:

- Advising the principal, Mr. Nathan Lane, and staff in the development of a site plan for English learners and submitting the plan to the School Site Council for consideration of inclusion in the School Plan for Student Achievement.
- Assisting in the development of the schoolwide needs assessment.
- Ways to make parents aware of the importance of regular school attendance.
- The SHS ELAC shall have the opportunity to elect at least one member to the Selma Unified School District English Learner Advisory Committee (DELAC).



### **SHS SSC**

The SHS School Site Council is a team comprised of the school principal, Mr. Nathan Lane, teachers, other staff, parents and/or community members, and students who develop the School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) for programs funded through Title 1 and or LCFF supplemental/concentration grant funding.

The SHS SCC is responsible for:

- Analyzing student data and school information.
- Identifying student need and areas for improvement based on student data.

- Participating in the creation and revision of the SPSA, including the proposed expenditure of funds.
- Provide ongoing review throughout the school year of the implementation of the strategies/services in the SPSA to ensure the plan is being carried out to address the needs of the school and its students and making modifications to the SPSA as needed.

- Participate in important decision-making that can bring positive benefits to students.
- Represent the entire school community and take responsibility for the achievement of all students.
- Learn about school governance and funding.
