

Appendix A

Hearing Conservation Plan Compliance Checklist

The following checklist is intended to provide a quick reference for an individual school district to evaluate their level of compliance with OSHA's Occupational Noise Exposure Standard (29 CFR 1910.95).

- Program administrator designated.
- Job/Work-Task Classifications where potential noise exposure could exceed 85 decibels over an eight-hour, time-weighted average have been identified.
- A noise monitoring program has been implemented.
- All exposed employees are participating in an audiometric testing program.
- Hearing protection devices have been provided to all employees exposed to noise that exceeds the permissible noise exposure.
- Employees have received training.
- Copies of the OSHA standard and related informational materials are available to employees.
- All records of employee exposure measurements and audiometric testing are kept according to the OSHA standard.

Note: This checklist is not intended to be comprehensive in nature. Each school district should refer to their respective Hearing Conservation Plan which further outlines general compliance requirements.
