Enjoy these optional learning activities this week!

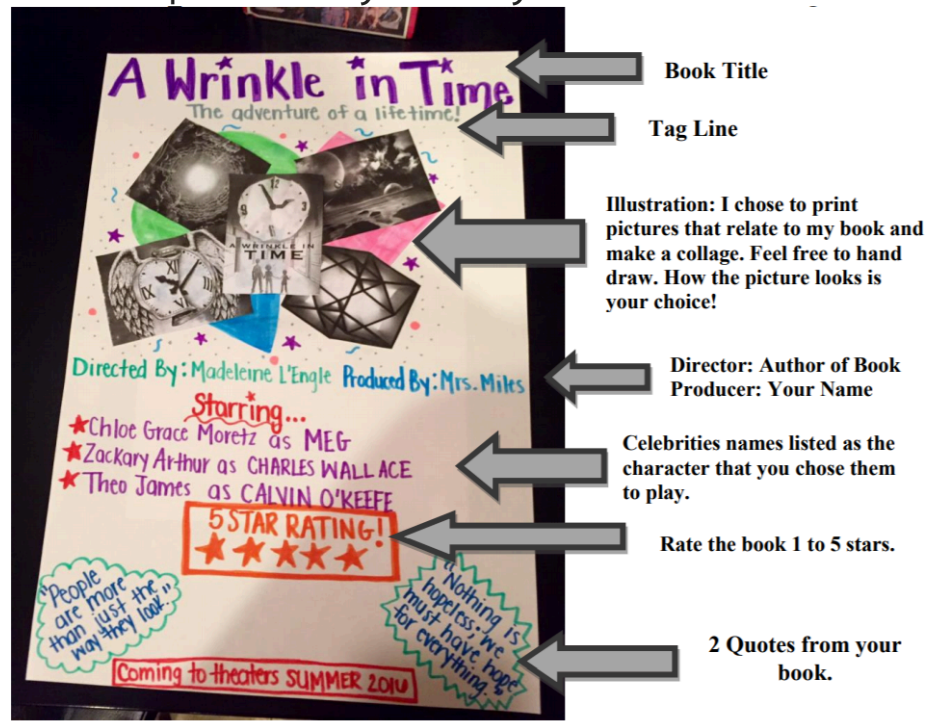

  - Tag line
  - Illustration
  - Director: Author of Book
  - Producer: Your name
  - Celebrities listed as the characters you would like them to play
  - Rate the book 1-5 stars
  - Two quotes from your story

<p><b>Social Studies</b></p>	<p><b>Activity Description</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pick a region</li> </ul> <p><b>Directions</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Think of the four major regions we learned about this year. We discussed the east, midwest, south, and the west. Pick the region you think you would like to live in and why you would want to live in that region. Think about the landforms, climate, and activities each region offers. Write a short paragraph telling which region you chose and why.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Science</b></p>	<p><b>Activity Description</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cool science experiment/observation</li> </ul> <p><b>Directions</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pour whole milk(vitamin D) in a bowl (about 1 inch deep)</li> <li>• Let it get to room temperature</li> <li>• Put a few drops of food coloring in the milk(use multiple colors if you have them)</li> <li>• Put 5 drops of dishwashing liquid into milk(Dawn works best if you have it)</li> <li>• Observe what happens and why you think it happened</li> <li>• Hint-we used whole milk which has the most fat in it and Dawn which "Gets the grease out"</li> <li>• Have Fun!</li> </ul>
