Science

Activity Description

- Cool science experiment/observation

Directions

- Pour whole milk(vitamin D) in a bowl (about 1 inch deep)
- Let it get to room temperature
- Put a few drops of food coloring in the milk(use multiple colors if you have them)
- Put 5 drops of dishwashing liquid into milk(Dawn works best if you have it)
- Observe what happens and why you think it happened
- Hint-we used whole milk which has the most fat in it and Dawn which "Gets the grease out"
