# LOWER SCHOOL (1-2)

## THE K-2 LOWER SCHOOL EXPERIENCE

### SCHOOL DAY

8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

### HOMEROOM

9:1 student-teacher ratio + 1 teaching assistant.  
115 students total in grades K-2.

### TEACHERS AND SPECIALISTS

Three lead teachers and three teaching assistants provide daily instruction for K and 1; third homeroom will be added for 2<sup>nd</sup> grade in the 25-26 school year; full-time counselor and nurse; specialist teachers for art, music, library, physical education and STEM.

### CONFERENCES

Conferences in October and March; written reports in October, December, March, and May.

### LEARNING SPACES

Three large homerooms for each class with distinct learning areas; art and music classrooms, gym, STEM lab, library, and dynamic playground.

### LUNCH/SNACKS

Daily choice of school lunch or bring your own.

### RECESS AND FIELD TRIPS

Daily outdoor recess and day trips throughout the year such as Lazy 5 Ranch, Riverbanks Zoo, Children's Theater, and Lineberger's Farm.

### TRADITIONS

Graduation (K), Rainforest Program (grade 1), 13 Colonies Program (grade 2), Field Day (grades 1 & 2), Christmas Program, Book Fair, 100<sup>th</sup> Day of School, and school-wide Spring festival.

### TRANSPORTATION

SouthLake Christian a.m./p.m. bus routes, carpool system.

### AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

Typically runs from 2:30 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. (additional cost).

Students come from seven counties in the Lake Norman, Denver, and Charlotte area.

### CAMPUS

30-acre main campus with educational and athletic facilities, and playgrounds. The well-maintained facilities include three academic buildings, a gymnasium, a field house (with weightlifting, classroom and training rooms), a baseball complex, a cross-country course, and a turf athletic field for soccer, lacrosse and football. A new arts building is expected to be completed in 2025 and an additional turf field and track is currently in the design phase.
