

DUAL ENROLLMENT VS. DUAL CREDIT COURSES

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- Dual Credit-- Taught by a CCHS teacher
 - Receive **both** CCHS high school credit & JALC college credit
- Dual Enrollment-- Taught on the JALC campus or online
 - Receive JALC college credit **ONLY!**

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SIGN-UP, APPLY, & REGISTER

- Sign-up in **SCOIR** to meet with a JALC Advisor at CCHS on **Nov. 10** or **Dec. 13**
- Apply to JALC if you have never taken a dual credit/enrollment class
 - **Complete this JALC application**
- Meet with a JALC Advisor during your appointment and choose your classes
 - Once you have registered, use the **Getting Started** packet for next steps

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TAKE THE ACCUPLACER TEST

- You must take the ACCUPLACER to be eligible for dual credit/enrollment classes
 - Check with JALC Advisors to see if you already have a valid score
 - ****EXCEPTION: Your SAT score may be used instead****
- You will need to schedule a time to take the ACCUPLACER at JALC in order to take dual credit and/or dual enrollment classes
 - Must have a valid ACCUPLACER before January 12, 2023
