The third interview for the Yuba County Superintendent of Schools position began at 11:20am. Candidate Rob Gregor introduced himself to the Board. Each Trustee introduced themselves.

The Board conducted an interview of Mr. Gregor. The interview concluded at 11:59am.

The fourth interview for the Yuba County Superintendent of Schools position began at 12:15pm. Candidate Karen Villalobos introduced

herself to the Board. Each Trustee introduced themselves.

The Board conducted an interview of Ms. Villalobos. The interview concluded at 12:55pm.

The Board finalized their interview scores and provided feedback on the selection of two final interview candidates.

After receiving direction from the Board, Leadership Associates Consultants announced that Rob Gregor and Karen Villalobos would be asked to return for final interviews.

Candidate Karen Villalobos' 2nd interview started at 2:30pm. Ms. Villalobos responded to interview questions. The interview concluded at 3:15pm.

Candidate Rob Gregor's 2<sup>nd</sup> interview started at 3:30pm. Mr. Gregor responded to interview questions. The interview concluded at 4:11pm.

Members of the public were given 2 minutes to address the Board.

The Board deliberated in open session.

Upon a motion by Trustee Nicoletti, duly seconded by Tracy Bishop, it was unanimously decided to select Rob Gregor as finalist for the position. A formal appointment will take place at the August 9, 2023, Regular Meeting of the Yuba County Board of Education.

President Renicker informed Mr. Gregor that he was selected as the finalist for the Yuba County Superintendent of Schools position and that the Board intends to appoint him on August 9, 2023. Mr. Gregor agreed to accept the position.
