PRIORITIES

- Utilize student feedback and faculty expertise to refine elective courses, continually assess program effectiveness, and adapt offerings to align with emerging educational trends.
- Expand Advanced Placement (AP), College Level (CL), and Early College Experience (ECE) programs, support faculty development in teaching rigorous courses, and enhance access for all students.
- Increase advanced STEM courses, cultivate industry partnerships for practical learning experiences, and secure grants to support digital and hands-on learning tools.
- Refine the Summer Accelerated Course Program by expanding course offerings to include credit-bearing courses for middle school students, providing greater curriculum flexibility for current Cadets, and offering additional onboarding opportunities to boost grade 9 students' academic and social confidence.
- Integrate cultural field trips and site visits into curriculum, develop critical thinking through pre and post-trip activities, expand
 extracurricular programs, and empower student leadership in designing and executing educational initiatives.

Redefine our Landscape

St. Joseph High School's Facilities Department is committed to modernizing and optimizing the campus environment. Concurrently, a comprehensive short-term plan outlines the renovation of our current building ensuring a refreshed infrastructure by September 2024.

PRIORITIES

- Complete the development of the schematic design documents to advance the Campus Master Plan and improve campus infrastructure; collaborate on updates aligning with adaptive space reutilization efforts; and design the Community Commons Project with new communal, performance, and athletic spaces.
- Schedule renovations for public areas, restrooms, and hallways by the end of the 2024 school year to ensure readiness for the September 2024 opening, and evaluate facilities and grounds to support currently thriving and developing athletic programs with sustainable solutions.
