

SCHOOL SUPPLIES LIST

LCHS 2024-2025 Junior High (Grades 7-8)



Welcome to Liberty Common High School. We are looking forward to working with your student in the fall and have created a supplies list to help everyone start off well. Teachers strongly recommend individual binders for each class; different colors for the binders will aid with organization. Junior-high lockers have shelves which accommodate 7 binders, books, and other supplies. The true “high-school prep” approach involves taking home each class binder whenever there is homework in that class. If preferred, the alternative is to use a homework accordion file. It is also important that students have notecards during the first month so they can practice making flashcards, which is an essential study skill at LCHS. Please note that some of the supplies required for core classes may change slightly at the teacher’s discretion at the start of school. This list should help you get the bulk of the supplies for your classes. More details about the binder size and organization requirements for specific classes will be provided at the beginning of school.

Core Classes

Binders (max 11 in. deep, different colors) and Paper/Note-Taking

- 3 - 2 in. three-ring binders
- 3 - 1½ in. three-ring binders
- 2 - 1 in. three-ring binders
- 6 packages binder tab dividers (8/pkg)
- College-ruled lined paper to fill binders (2-3 packages, may need more during the year)
- 1 non-black three-ring binder used for a writing portfolio throughout grades 7-12 (**7th grade and all new-to-Liberty students**)
- 1 package of ¼” square graph paper
- 2 college-ruled composition books/spiral notebooks
- 2-3 packages of lined 3 x 5 notecards (may need more during the year)

Pencil Bag/Supplies

- Pencil bag to hold following items:
 - Pencils- wooden/mechanical, extra lead
 - Pens (black, blue, red)
 - Pencil sharpener
 - Highlighters, different colors
 - Large eraser
 - Package of colored pencils
 - Ruler
 - Small scissors
 - Glue stick
 - Scientific calculator TI-30Xa
 - Large book covers (3), including 1 jumbo size if student is taking pre-Algebra or Introductory Algebra (large paper grocery bags work well)
- Planner - where the entire week is visible when open, and has enough room to write assignments for 8 classes a day
 - 7th-grade students will be given an LCCHS planner during the orientation meeting.
 - 8th-grade students can use a store-bought planner or purchase an LCCHS planner for \$7.00 from the front office the week before school begins.

Course Fees: Beginning with the 2024-2025 school year, individual class fees will be discontinued and replaced with a consolidated academic fee of \$80 (\$50 for student activities and \$30 for academic materials) for all students in grades 7-8, assessed at the beginning of the school year during the annual online registration process in August.

Miscellaneous

- Access to an internet-capable computer outside of class to do homework
- One subject spiral notebook and Spanish-English Dictionary for Spanish 1
- Personal notebook for English 8
- Graph paper, pens of various colors, metal compass (center-wheel style preferred), and protractor for Geometry
- PE Uniform - 7th grade; uniforms will be handed out when class begins and cost is covered in the consolidated academic fee. (PE uniforms are required for all PE courses; students in grades 8-12 are encouraged to reuse uniforms in good condition. If a student needs to purchase an additional uniform, there will be a fee of \$18 assessed to his/her account to be paid via our online payment system.)

Drawing Foundations

- Sketchbook: **11" x 14"**; spiral-bound; smooth surface labeled for sketching, drawing, or graphite; minimum **68 lb. (100gsm)** which refers to the weight of the paper and will be noted on the cover; minimum **50** pages
- This sketchbook may also be used for other art classes requiring a sketchbook.

3D Design & Sculpture Foundations

- Sketchbook, any size or type
- Mechanical pencils

Studio Art Foundations

- Sketchbook, any size or type
- Cotton T-shirt, sweatshirt, or tote bag washed without fabric softener

Graphic Design Foundations

- USB flash drive (32 GB minimum)
- Compass
- Protractor
- Sketchbook, any size or type
- Optional: High quality markers, colored pencils, illustration pens, and stencils

Photography Foundations

- 2 SD cards (minimum 32 GB) with your name on them
- 1” binder for storage of film and prints
- Digital Camera with manual controls (MASP or Av, Tv, M; ISO and white balance controls)*
- Film camera with manual controls (needs shutter, aperture, and ISO controls)*

*Note: If you do not have access to one or both of these cameras, then you may use the school cameras. However, our equipment supply is limited so please do your best to acquire your own.
