

# MILLER FINE ARTS MAGNET MIDDLE SCHOOL 2024-2025 STUDENT DRESS CODE



# **STUDENTS MAY WEAR THE FOLLOWING:**

### **PANTS OR SKIRTS:**

- Plain khaki, black, or navy pants; plain jeans or plain khaki, black, or navy skirts.
- Black or blue jeans are allowed daily. However, jeans must not have rips or frays.
- No sweatpants, cargo pants, camo pants, athletic joggers, dry-fit pants, leather pants, jeggings, leggings, biker shorts, or yoga pants.
- Shorts, Skirts, dresses, and skorts no shorter than two (2) inches above the knee may be worn. Shorts must be in the dress code colors: black or blue jeans, plain khaki, black, or navy.
- Pants must be of an appropriate size, worn as designed, and of ankle length. Sagging pants or pants designed to be worn below the top of the hip bone are not allowed.
- Pants/shorts/skirts must be appropriate, not excessively tight or revealing undergarments.
- Skirts/skorts must be no shorter than two (2) inches above the knee. Skirts cannot have any splits or openings.
- Overalls, rompers, and jumpsuits are not allowed.

#### **SHIRTS:**

- Plain white, blue (navy or royal), light blue, gray, black, and yellow collared polo shirts ONLY.
- Polo shirts can be long-sleeved or short-sleeved. Sleeveless is not allowed.
- School Spirit T-shirts, sweatshirts, sweaters, plain white, blue (navy or royal) or yellow sweatshirts and sweaters may be worn.
- All shirts must be appropriate and not expose any portion of the waist, hips, midriff, low-cut, see-through, or sleeveless).
- Plain white undershirts or turtlenecks may be worn underneath polo shirts, school t-shirts, sweatshirts, and sweaters.

#### JACKETS/HOODIES/SWEATSHIRTS:

- Plain (no patterns/graphic/stripes) white, blue (navy or royal), black or yellow jackets ONLY. School jackets will be available to purchase.
- Plain blue jean jackets are permitted with no rips, frays, or embellishments.
- Plain (no patterns/graphic/ stripes) white, blue (navy or royal), black or yellow sweatshirts or hoodies ONLY. School hoodies will be available to purchase.
- Jackets with hoods or hoodies <u>MUST NOT</u> be worn in the school building.
- No oversized coats may be worn in the school building. Lightweight jackets with <u>NO HOOD</u> can be worn in the classroom.

#### **SHOES AND SOCKS:**

- All shoes must have closed toes and heels. No slippers, flip flops, shoes with wheels, or slides allowed.
- Crocs are NOT allowed. However, Crocs in sports mode "will be permitted on special days designated by the principal.
- Soft-soled shoes may be worn. No heels or stilettos allowed.
- Tennis shoes can be worn with shoelaces that are the appropriate size for the shoe. All shoelaces must be tied.
- Students must have on socks.
- Socks should not be tucked in pants.

## **ACCESSORIES:**

- Students are NOT permitted to wear hats, head scarves, wave caps, bonnets, hoods, or bandanas. (This includes edge control bands.)
- Students are not to wear fishnet hosiery in place of leggings.
- Students are not permitted to wear gloves inside the building.
- Facial piercings such as the nose, lips, tongue, eyelid, etc., are not allowed.
- Students must not have Band-Aids for fashion or pimple patches.
- Belts must not have an oversized buckle.
- Gold or Silver pendants, bracelets, and necklaces. Dog tags are not allowed.
- Earrings larger than a quarter and multiple bracelets are not allowed.
- Purses must be 6X9 or no larger than half of a sheet of paper.
- Purses and male crossbody bags must be secured in the student lockers. Fanny packs are not allowed.
- Nonprescription glasses or sunglasses may not be worn inside the building.
- Mesh bookbags only. Student locker rental will be available for a fee.
- Electronic devices (Cell phones, Smartwatches, Air Pods, Headphones, or Bluetooth headsets) are NOT ALLOWED to be used during the instructional day (8:35 PM-4:05 PM). The school is not responsible for lost or stolen personal electronic devices.

## **HAIR:**

• Each student's hair must be neat, clean, and well-groomed. Dyed hair that is not a natural color or shade is not allowed except for days when spirit day activities are designated by the principal. "Unnatural" hair color includes, but is not limited to, hair that is dyed shades of pink, shades of purple, shades of red, shades of orange, yellow that is not blonde, shades of blue, or shades of green. In addition, any hairstyle and/or hair accessories that could cause a disruption to the school setting may be prohibited at the principal's discretion.

Disclaimer: Any article of clothing that advertises alcohol, drugs, sex, or gang activity, advocates the use of a product, or contains inflammatory, vulgar, lewd, or suggestive writing, pictures, emblems, or promotion of aggression or violence is not allowed. In addition, any clothing that disrupts or distracts the learning process based on the judgment of the principal (designee) will not be allowed. Students must follow the dress code on designated "dress down" days.
